This notification is issued for registrations of the candidates appearing for MDS Part II (New Regulation) Supplementary Examinations, commencing from **15.11.2022**.

1) Eligibility to appear for MDS Part II (New Regulation) Supplementary Examinations:

- The PG Dental Degree students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2019-20 into Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS, whose admissions are approved by the KNRUHS and those who have cleared the MDS Part I Examination and students who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examination conducted earlier are eligible to appear for MDS Part II (New Regulation) Examinations.
- 2) The students should put in academic year wise compulsory attendance of **80% (Eighty Percent)** in each year.
 - 3) Approval of Dissertation work is an essential prerequisite for a candidate to appear in the University Examination.
 - 4) The calculation of the attendance percentage is up to **15.10.2022**.
 - 5) The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks is from **17.10.2022** to **18.10.2022**.
 - 6) The confirmation date for attendance and internal marks uploaded is **22.10.2022**.

7) **Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet**

The University is a digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For MDS course, single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.

Scheme of Examination:

The MDS Part II (Final Year) (New Regulations) Examination shall consist of Paper I, Paper II & Paper III, each of three hours duration.

Paper I	Two (2) long answer questions carrying 25 marks each and five (5) questions carrying 10 marks each.
Paper II	Two (2) long answer questions carrying 25 marks each and five (5) questions carrying 10 marks each.
Paper III	Three (3) questions will be given and student have to answer any two (2) questions. Each question carries 50 marks.

- The candidates shall have to secure a minimum of 50% (FIFTY PERCENT) marks in MDS Part I examination and shall have to pass MDS Part I examination at least six months prior to the MDS Part II (Final) examination.
- To pass the University Examination, a candidate shall secure in both theory and in practical/clinical including viva voce independently with an aggregate of 50% (FIFTY PERCENT) of total marks allotted (50 marks out of 100 marks in Part I examination and 150 marks out of 300 marks in Part II examination in theory and 150 marks out of 300 marks in clinical plus viva- voce together).
