ORDER:

The Registrar, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana State in his letter 4th read above inter-alia has proposed some amendments to the Rules of Admissions into Post Graduate Medical/ Dental Courses in Private Medical/ Dental un aided non minority institutions as notified in G.Os 1st cited, in view of the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court vide reference 2nd cited, MCC notice vide reference 3rd cited and as per the recommendations of Committee Constituted to prevent seat blocking.

- 2. Government after careful examination of the matter have decided to amend the Telangana State Private Medical/Dental Un-aided Non-Minority Institutions (Admissions into Post Graduate Medical/Dental Courses) Rules, 2017 issued in G.Os. 1st read above.
- 3. Accordingly the following notification shall be published in the Telangana Gazette Dated: 25.08.2022.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act 1983 (Act No. 5 of 1983), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following amendments to Telangana State Private Medical/Dental Un-aided Non-Minority Institutions (Admissions into Post Graduate Medical/Dental Courses) Rules, 2017, dated.09.05.2017.

1. In Rule 3 under the head 'Seat Sharing and Admissions' after sub-rule (vi), the following shall be added:-

After the last phase of counseling by the University, leftover seats shall be permitted to be filled by the Management of the respective colleges from the relevant merit list in accordance with the vacancies. The University shall notify a merit list of eligible candidates on the University website at 1:10 ratio in proportion to the total number of vacant seats available in all medical colleges in obedience to the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P.(C) No.267/2017 and others from which selection will have to be done.

2. In Rule under the head 'Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG [Medical, Dental] Courses' under the Management Quota Seats after subrule (3), the following shall be added:-

No fresh registrations are permitted after the last date of online registration as notified by the University.

- 3. In Rule under the head Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG [Medical, Dental] Courses under the Management Quota Seats in place of sub-rule 6 and 7, the following shall be substituted:-
 - 6. a. Web based counseling shall be conducted by the University and all Candidates have to exercise web options as per the schedule notified by the University.
 - 6. b. All registered and eligible candidates shall exercise web options.
 - 6. c. For the Management category seats to which they are eligible from the first phase of counseling onwards. If the candidate does not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, he/she shall not be eligible for further phases of counseling.
 - 6. d. Selected candidates have to download the allotment letter after payment of University fee through payment gateway and shall report to the concerned Principal for admission.
 - 6. e. Candidate shall pay the tuition fee, submit all original certificates and necessary bonds at the respective institutions at the time of admission.
 - 6. f. Candidates shall be permitted to submit bank guarantee for tuition fee of ensuing academic year within one month after closure of admissions.
 - 6. g. After second phase of counseling, admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw from the course and admitted candidates are not eligible for upgradation in the subsequent phases of counseling of All India Quota or State Quota of admissions.
 - 7. a. The candidates who are admitted into PG courses in the second phase of counseling onwards including slided candidates (candidates who have joined in the previous phase of counseling) have to continue in the course without fail to prevent wastage of seats and to prevent seat blocking. Otherwise, all such candidates will be debarred for three years for admission into Postgraduate Medical Degree /Diploma course in the state of Telangana besides payment of Rs.50,00,000-00 (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) to KNRUHS towards forfeiture of bond.
 - 7. b. All the candidates joining the Postgraduate degree or diploma course should execute a bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- value to ensure undertaking to complete prescribed period of training. In case of the default, such candidate shall pay an amount of Rs.50,00,000 (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) to KNR University of Health Sciences.
- 4. In Rule under the head 'Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG [Medical, Dental] Courses' under the Management Quota Seats in place of sub-rule (11), the following shall be substituted:-

The Principals of all Medical colleges shall have in their custody the original certificates of all the admitted candidates and these shall be verified by the inspection teams constituted by the University/State Government after every phase of counseling.

4. In Rule 3 under the head Seat Sharing and Admissions after sub-rule (vi), the following shall be added:-

After the last phase of counseling by the University, leftover seats shall be permitted to be filled by the Management of the respective colleges from the relevant merit list in accordance with the vacancies. The University shall notify a merit list of eligible candidates on the University website at 1:10 ratio in proportion to the total number of vacant seats available in all medical colleges in obedience to the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P.(C) No.267/2017 and others from which selection will have to be done.

5. In Rule under the head 'Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG [Medical, Dental] Courses' under the Management Quota Seats after sub-rule (3), the following shall be added:-

No fresh registrations are permitted after the last date of online registration as notified by the University.

- 6. In Rule under the head 'Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG [Medical, Dental] Courses' under the Management Quota Seats in place of sub-rule (6 and 7), the following shall be substituted:-
- 6 a. Web based counseling shall be conducted by the University and all Candidates have to exercise web options as per the schedule notified by the University.
- 6.b. All registered and eligible candidates shall exercise web options for the Management category seats to which they are eligible from the first phase of counseling onwards. If the candidate does not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, he/she shall not be eligible for further phases of counseling.
- 6 c. Selected candidates have to download the allotment letter after payment of University fee through payment gateway and shall report to the concerned Principal for admission.
- 6 d. Candidate shall pay the tuition fee, submit all original certificates and necessary bonds at the respective institutions at the time of admission.
- 6 e. Candidates shall be permitted to submit bank guarantee for tuition fee of ensuing academic year within one month after closure of admissions.
- 6 f. After second phase of counseling, admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw from the course and admitted candidates are not eligible for up gradation in the subsequent phases of counseling of All India Quota or State Quota of admissions.
- 7 a. The candidates who are admitted into PG courses in the second phase of counseling onwards including slided candidates (candidates who have joined in the previous phase of counseling) have to continue in the course without fail to prevent wastage of seats and to prevent seat blocking. Otherwise, all such candidates will be debarred for three years for admission into Postgraduate Medical Degree /Diploma course in the state of Telangana besides payment of Rs.50,00,000-00 (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) to KNRUHS towards forfeiture of bond.
- 7 b. All the candidates joining the Postgraduate degree or diploma course should execute a bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- value to ensure undertaking to complete prescribed period of training. In case of the default, such candidate shall pay an amount of Rs.50,00,000-00 (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) to KNR University of Health Sciences.
- 7. In Rule under the head Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG [Medical, Dental] Courses under the Management Quota Seats in place of sub-rule (11), the following shall be substituted:-

The Principals of all Medical colleges shall have in their custody the original certificates of all the admitted candidates and these shall be verified by the inspection teams constituted by the University/State Government after every phase of counseling.
