FIRST MBBS (NEW REGULATIONS) REGULAR EXAMINATIONS NOTIFICATION, NOVEMBER 2023

Sub:- KNRUHS – Exams – Conduct of First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular examinations in the month of November, 2023 – Issue of Notification - Regarding.

Ref: - Orders of the Vice – Chancellor, Dated:06.09.2023.

The notification is issued for registration of candidates for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations commencing from **14.11.2023**.

Eligibility to appear for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations:

- 1. The First MBBS students who have been admitted during the academic year 2022-23 into the Medical colleges affiliated to KNRUHS in Telangana State, whose admissions are approved by the KNRUHS and also the students who have failed, detained or not appeared for the previously held examinations i.e., not more than four attempts are eligible to appear for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular examinations in the month of November, 2023.
- 2. The First MBBS students who are having 75% or MORE ATTENDANCE IN THEORY AND 80% or MORE ATTENDANCE IN PRACTICALS and scored 50% of marks and above in internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- 3. The candidate should secure minimum 40% in each paper and aggregate of 50% in Theory and 50% in Practicals separately for passing the University exam.
- 4. Cutoff date for calculation of attendance percentage is **01.10.2023.**
- 5. The upload of attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the candidates is from **05.10.2023** to **07.10.2023**.

6. The confirmation date for attendance & internal assessment marks of the candidates is on 09.10.2023. ANY CORRECTION AFTER THE CONFIRMATION DATE IS NOT ENTERTAINED.

Special Note to 2019 batch and from 2020 batch onwards students:

- In pursuance to the NMC, New Delhi circular Dated:12-05-2023 of the Secretary, National Medical Commission, New Delhi, wherein it is circulated to allow one additional attempt (5th attempt) to such MBBS students who are admitted in Medical Colleges during the academic year 2019 -20 & could not pass their First Professional MBBS Examinations. * RELAXATION IS ONLY FOR 2019-20 ADMITTED STUDENTS.
- As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No. 11.2.7 for 2019 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass FIRST PROFESSIONAL examinations. The total period for successful completion of first Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.

<u>Digital Valuation and Providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet</u>

The University is a Digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For First MBBS, exam will be conducted with single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page for the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.
