Sub:- KNRUHS – Exams – Conducting of **First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular** examinations in the month of August, 2026 – Issue of Notification – Regarding.

Ref:- Orders of the Hon'ble Vice – Chancellor.

This notification is issued for registration of the candidates to appear for **First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular** Examinations commencing from **12.08.2026**.

Eligibility to appear for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations:

1. The First MBBS students who have been admitted during the academic year **2025-26** into the medical colleges affiliated to KNRUHS in Telangana State, whose admissions are approved by the KNRUHS and also the students of previous batches who have failed, detained or not appeared for the examinations conducted earlier i.e., not more than four attempts are eligible to appear for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular examinations in the month of August, 2026.
2. The First MBBS students who are having minimum **75% ATTENDANCE IN THEORY AND 80% ATTENDANCE IN PRACTICAL/CLINICAL** and scored minimum **50% MARKS** in internal assessment examinations in each subject are eligible to appear for the examinations.
3. The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the students is up to **16.06.2026**.
4. The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the students is from **20.06.2026** to **23.06.2026**.
5. The confirmation date for uploaded attendance and internal assessment marks is on **26.06.2026**.

- As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No. 11.2.7 for 2019-20 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass First Professional examinations. The total period for successful completion of First Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.

Digital Valuation and Providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:

The University is a Digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. **For First MBBS**, exam will be conducted with single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page for the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.
