NOTIFICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION INTO MBBS AND BDS COURSES UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27 INTO GOVERNMENT & UN-AIDED PRIVATE NON-MINORITY & MINORITY MEDICAL COLLEGES AND GOVERNMENT & UN-AIDED PRIVATE NON-MINORITY DENTAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO KNRUHS, TELANGANA

Online applications are invited from the candidates who have qualified by securing the cutoff scores or above in UG National Eligibility-cum- Entrance Test (NEET) 2026 for admission into the Under Graduate Medical and Dental Courses for the academic year 2026-27 under Competent Authority Quota into Government and Private Medical & Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS, Warangal in the State of Telangana.

This notification is issued for online registration for web-based counselling to determine State Merit position for admission into Competent Authority Quota seats only, i.e., the seats in Government Medical / Dental Colleges after deducting 15% of seats contributed to All India Quota and Category 'A' seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority and Minority Medical colleges, Private Un-aided Non-Minority Dental Colleges including Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad. Total number of seats available under Competent Authority Quota in all categories along with seat matrix for the academic year 2026-27 will be notified on KNRUHS website before exercising web options for counselling.

The tuition fee for the academic year 2026–27 shall be as per the Orders to be issued by the Government of Telangana.

CUT-OFF SCORE IN NEET UG 2026

Candidates should have secured the following cut-off score or above in NEET UG 2026 Examination.

Persons with Disability (PWD) candidates of General / Un-Reserved / Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)	45 th Percentile	194

Schedule for registration through online and uploading of all relevant certificates:

Candidates can register online and upload scanned original certificates on the website <https://tsmedadm.tsche.in> from **06.00 AM** on **05.08.2026** up to **06.00 PM** on **12.08.2026**.

Provisional Merit position of the registered candidates will be prepared based on the NEET UG 2026 rank and other eligibility criteria notified here under after verification of scanned original certificates. Final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission at allotted college by the admission committee of the college.

ELIGIBILITY:

The candidates, who have qualified in NEET UG 2026 by securing cut-off marks or above have to apply for determining the State Merit position for Competent Authority Quota seats subject to the conditions specified in admission Regulations/Prospectus for the AY 2026-27.

A candidate for admission into Under graduate courses under Competent Authority Quota in Telangana should be Indian Nationals, Person of Indian Origin (PIO) or Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card holders (PIO/OCI status issued before 04-03-2021) and shall fulfil the following provisions in G.O.Ms.No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Date: 19.07.2024 and G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Date: 08.09.2025.

- (i) If the candidate has studied in an Educational Institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

- (ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in Educational Institutions, if he has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.
- (iii) Local area herein means the State of Telangana. Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the local area as stated at (ii) above, to be eligible for admission into Under graduate courses under Competent Authority Quota, the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana.

- I. Provided that a candidate who studies outside Telangana for any period during the requisite four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination, will be eligible to be considered if they fall under any of the below categories:
 1. Children of employees of the Telangana State Government who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 2. Children of serving or retired officers belonging to the Telangana cadre of All India Services (IAS/IFS/IPS) who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 3. Children of defence personnel/ex-servicemen/Central Armed Police Force service who, at the time of joining service, have declared their hometown to be in the State of Telangana and who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 4. Children of employees of a Corporation/Agency/Instrumentality under Government of Telangana, liable to be transferred anywhere in India as per the terms and conditions of his/her employment, who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
- II. Subject to the candidate submitting certificate of employment from the competent authority for the candidate's father/mother's service outside the State for the period corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

In accordance with NMC Regulations,

the candidate should have passed Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Biotechnology and English.

- OC/EWS candidates should obtain not less than 50% marks in science subjects.
- BC/SC/ST candidates should obtain not less than 40% marks in science subjects.
- OC/EWS PWD candidates should obtain not less than 45% marks in science subjects.

- The Candidate should have qualified in NEET UG 2026 as per cut-off scores notified above.

AGE:

The candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2026. The candidates who do not complete 17 years as on 31-12-2026 need not apply for the counselling. The above age criteria are applicable to all candidates of all categories.

- The candidates who claim admission under Persons with Disabilities (PWD) category shall mention in the online application as applying under PWD category and have to appear before a Medical Board to be constituted for the purpose by the University as per the schedule to be notified by the University for eligibility under PWD status.
- The candidates are advised to download and read the Prospectus/Regulations available in the website <http://www.knruhs.telangana.gov.in/> before filling the online application form for admission into MBBS & BDS Courses for the academic year 2026-27.
- NEET UG 2026 qualified and eligible candidates as per the concerned regulations who desire to take admission in to MBBS/BDS Courses in to Government, Private Un- aided Non- minority & Minority Medical colleges & Govt. Dental College and Private Non-Minority Dental Colleges including Army College of Dental Sciences shall apply online and to upload all original certificates for determining the Merit position for Telangana State Competent Authority Quota seats. The online application can be filled through any computer with an internet connection. (NOTE: PREFERABLY DESKTOP OR LAPTOP only)

REGISTRATION AND PROCESSING FEE:

- Candidates are advised to carefully read the Prospectus, University Regulations, relevant Government Orders (G.Os.), and the eligibility conditions prescribed in this notification before proceeding with the payment of the Registration and Processing Fee. **The Registration and Processing Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.** Therefore, candidates should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility criteria before making the payment, uploading relevant documents and submitting the online application.
- The Registration and Processing fee is as follows;

OC & BC candidates	Rs. 4,000/- (Bank transaction charges extra)
SC & ST candidates	Rs. 3,200/- (Bank transaction charges extra)

*Fee shall be paid online through Debit Card/Credit Card or Net Banking.

NOTE: Registration & Processing fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to a further date.

- In case of payment failure resulting in a subsequent successful payment (double payment), candidates shall submit their representation for refund of the failed/duplicate payment only through e-mail to **knruhs.doublepayments@gmail.com**. Upon verification, the amount received through the failed/duplicate transaction, if any, shall be refunded to the candidate's bank account by following due procedure only after the closure of admissions.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

- ❖ Online application forms without uploading the mandatory Certificates, Passport size photo, signature at declaration area and incomplete applications will be automatically rejected and will not be considered for determining the Merit position in respective categories using NEET UG 2026 Rank.
- ❖ The mere fact that merit position issued to a candidate does not imply that the candidature is accepted by the University and it does not mean that the entries made by the candidate in the online application are accepted as true and correct.
- ❖ Candidates may please note that the University will take up the verification of certificates with regard to eligibility conditions i.e., educational qualifications, Local status, category status, special category status as per uploaded relevant certificates by the concerned department officials. If the information furnished by the candidate in the application is incorrect, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled and further action that deemed fit will be taken.
- ❖ Candidates' eligibility for admission into UG courses for the academic year 2026-27 will be examined by the University only after scrutiny of application along with all uploaded copies of required certificates and provisional final merit list will be notified.
- ❖ **Registration along with uploading of Scanned Original certificates will be done only once irrespective of the number of counsellings. No separate notification will be issued for verification of original certificates. Therefore, the candidates should register and upload all the mandatory Certificates without fail.**
- ❖ This notification is for online registration for determining the State Merit position in respective categories using NEET UG 2026 Rank only for eligible candidates. The schedule for exercising web options for admission to MBBS/BDS courses will be notified separately on University website. Candidates are advised to check the University website for notifications, counselling schedule, seat matrix and other details from time to time.
- ❖ An in-eligible candidate obtaining Merit position does not make the candidate eligible for admission. Admission will be considered only for candidates, who have secured

marks above cutoff score in NEET UG 2026 examination and based on the state merit order as the case may be.

- ❖ Scrutiny of uploaded Original Certificates shall be conducted by the University and concerned departmental officials. After scrutiny of application and certificates, provisional merit list will be released. Candidates are advised to refer to University website for further details regarding schedule of exercising web options. **No individual communication will be sent.**
- ❖ Admissions will be in accordance with the procedure notified in Rules of Admission vide G.O.Ms.No. 114, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated. 05.07.2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated.22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No 75, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated.04.07.2023, G.O. Ms No.33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated:19.07.2024, G.O. Ms No.150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated:08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble Supreme Court/High Court orders.
- ❖ Candidates have to exercise web options for seats in the colleges in which they are interested to join for MBBS course and BDS course separately. Candidates and parents are informed to exercise web options very carefully in the order of their preference for colleges and also to take a print out of exercised web options which are uploaded for reference.
- ❖ After allotment, the candidate should pay the University fee and download the allotment order, submit the print out of the filled-in Online application form, allotment order, Bonds and original certificates along with (1) set of self-attested copies to the Principal of allotted college at the time of joining for final verification by the admissions committee of the allotted college. The Admission Committee is responsible for scrutiny of the original certificates submitted by the candidate. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment order for admission will be cancelled.
