This notification is issued for registrations of the candidates appearing for Second BNYS Part II regular examinations, commencing from 27.07.2022.

**1) Eligibility to appear for Second BNYS Part II Regular Examinations:**

The BNYS students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2018-19 whose admissions are approved by the University and completed study period with 75% attendance (both theory & practical separately) and 35% of internal assessment marks in each subject and students who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examination conducted earlier are eligible to appear for the examination subject to the course regulations.

- 2) The calculation of the attendance percentage is up to **15.06.2022**.
- 3) The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks is from **23.06.2022** to **24.06.2022**.
- 4) The confirmation date for attendance and internal marks uploaded is **25.06.2022**.
- 5) **Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet**

The University is a Digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. **SECOND BNYS Part-II**, exam will be conducted with single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page for the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.
