BDS ADMISSIONS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

Notification for exercising web-options for Second Phase of Counseling for admission into BDS course under Competent Authority Quota into affiliated Government, Private Dental Colleges and Army College of Dental Sciences for the AY 2025-26.

In continuation to this office notifications dated: 15.07.2025, 25.07.2025, 08.09.2025, 12.09.2025, 15.09.2025 & 19.09.2025, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences hereby notifies to conduct second phase of web based counseling under Competent Authority Quota (CQ) for admission into BDS course including PWD, Anglo Indian, PMC, CAP categories for the AY 2025-26 into Government, Private Dental Colleges and Army College of Dental Sciences in the State of Telangana.

Candidates whose certificates were uploaded at the time of online registration and verified by staff of concerned departments and whose names are notified as eligible candidates in the final merit list of UG Admissions on the KNRUHS website on 15.09.2025 are eligible to exercise web - options online from computer with internet connection.

All the eligible candidates whose names are displayed in the final merit list including PWD, Anglo Indian, PMC & CAP categories candidates on KNRUHS website can exercise web options for admission into BDS course from 03.00 PM on 01.10.2025 up to 03.00 PM on 03.10.2025 through website https://tsbdsadm.tsche.in/

For eligibility criteria and regulations, to refer the notifications dated: 15.07.2025.

- 1. The candidates who were allotted seats in the first phase of counselling and have not reported/discontinued the course at the respective dental college are not eligible for exercising web-options.
- 2. Candidates who have not exercised web-options in the first phase of counselling are not eligible to exercise web-options.
- 3. The candidates who were allotted BDS seats in the first phase of counselling, joined the course and continuing the course are eligible to exercise web-options.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Allotted Candidates have to pay University fee of Rs. 12,000/- for BDS

Course through payment Gateway by using Online payment method.

(Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and download the allotment letter.

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee is to be paid at respective Dental Colleges.

The tuition fee payable is as notified by the Government of Telangana.

- 2. The allotment of seats will be made in accordance with the selection procedure notified in Government orders G.O.Ms.No. 114, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 05.07.2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No. 75, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 04-07-2023, G.O. Ms. No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 19-07-2024, G.O.Ms.No. 10, Scheduled Castes Development (POA.A2) Department, Dated: 14.04.2025, G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble High Court/Supreme court orders and University regulations.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

- Eligible NEET-UG-2025 qualified candidates as per final merit list for Competent
 Authority Quota can exercise web options for BDS course in the affiliated Dental
 colleges of KNRUHS as per their interest and priority through
 https://tsbdsadm.tsche.in/ from computer with internet connection.
- 2. Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus for the Regulations for admission into BDS course under Competent Authority Quota and Government Orders on Rules of Admission on KNRUHS website before exercising web-options.
- 3. If a candidate is allotted a seat in BDS course as per his/her options and does not join the course, they shall not be permitted to exercise web options in the subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.

- 4. Candidates exercising web-options for BDS course are informed that there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options. Candidates can exercise web options for any number of colleges the candidate is interested to join as per candidate's eligibility. If candidates are not interested to join in any college, they should not exercise web-options for the same.
- 5. Candidates in the final merit list are informed that if they do not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, they are not eligible to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.
- 6. Candidates are advised to exercise web options for BDS seats in all colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of available vacant seats shown in seat matrix, as vacancies will arise during counselling process due to sliding of candidates from allotted seats in first phase of counselling to other seats as per their web-options in the second phase of counselling.
- 7. If a seat is allotted in this phase of counselling as per web-options exercised by the candidates in this phase of counselling, the seat allotted in first phase of counselling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore, candidates are informed to exercise web-options carefully for sliding with awareness of this fact.
- 8. One time pass word will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of exercising web-options. The pass word consists of SIX letter code with English capital A to Z. (For details read instructions to the candidates before giving options)
- 9. Candidates are instructed to take a print out of saved options.
- 10. Candidates will receive SMS message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if allotted. Candidates are also informed to login to check their allotment status on https://tsbdsadm.tsche.in/ website after each phase of counseling.
- 11. The selected candidates shall download the allotment order from the website after payment of the University fee by gateway method by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates should check their allotment and report to the Principal of respective Dental College on or before the date specified on the allotment order.
- 12. Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the respective Dental College before the last date for joining as specified on the allotment order, submit all original certificates, relevant bonds and pay the tuition fee/college fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the admission process within specified date for joining, the admission will be cancelled

automatically and the candidate's options shall not be considered for subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.

13. If the candidate slides to other college during second phase of counselling into the colleges affiliated to KNRUHS, the candidates have to get relieved from first phase joined college, to collect all original certificates, tuition fee and to report at the Principal

of allotted college before last date of joining. Candidates who do not join the course at

the allotted course in this phase of counselling are not eligible for further phases of

counselling.

14. Candidates are hereby informed that final verification of original certificates will

be conducted at the allotted Dental College and in case of any discrepancy, the

provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per

University regulations.

15. Original certificates submitted at the time of admissions shall not be returned to the

candidate, unless the candidate discontinues the course.

16. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
