# MBBS/BDS ADMISSIONS UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA i.e. B & C/NRI CATEGORY FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

Notification for exercising web-options for Mop Up Phase of Counseling for admission into MBBS/BDS courses under Management Quota i.e. B & C/NRI Category for the AY 2025-26 into affiliated Private Medical/Dental Colleges, Army College of Dental Sciences & Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences affiliated to Anurag University.

In continuation to this office notifications dated: 31.07.2025, 08.09.2025, 17.09.2025, 22.09.2025 & 04.10.2025, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences hereby notifies to conduct Mop Up phase of web-based counseling under Management Quota i.e. B & C/NRI Category for admission into MBBS/BDS courses for the AY 2025-26 into affiliated Private Medical/Dental Colleges, Army College of Dental Sciences & Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences affiliated to Anurag University.

Candidates whose names are notified as eligible candidates in the final merit list of MBBS/BDS Admissions under Management Quota & subsequent addendum/corrigendum notified on the KNRUHS website are eligible to exercise web - options through online from computer with internet connection.

All the eligible candidates whose names are displayed in the final merit list of Management Quota on KNRUHS website can exercise web options for admission into MBBS/BDS courses from 01.00 PM on 03.11.2025 up to 01.00 PM on 04.11.2025 through website <a href="https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/">https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/</a> as per the candidate's registration and eligibility for B & C/NRI categories.

- 1. The candidates who were allotted seats in the previous phases of counselling and have not reported/discontinued the course at the respective college are not eligible for exercising web-options.
- 2. Candidates who have not exercised web-options in the first phase of counselling are not eligible to exercise web-options.
- 3. Candidates whose names are notified in the college wise allotment list of MBBS course under Competent Authority Quota in Mop Up phase of counselling are not eligible to exercise web-options.

- 4. The candidates who were allotted MBBS/BDS seats in the previous phases of counselling under Management Quota, joined the course and continuing the course are eligible to exercise web-options.
- 5. Candidates who are admitted under MCC counselling up to third phase of counselling as notified on MCC website are not eligible to exercise web-options.

Candidates have to exercise web options for MBBS/BDS seats in order of preference for college and category under B & C/NRI Category.

For eligibility criteria and regulations refer to notifications dated: 31.07.2025.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Allotted Candidates have to pay the following University fee through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and download the allotment order. Candidates who have paid University fee in the previous phases need not pay again.

**TUITION FEE:** Tuition fee is to be paid at the respective Medical College.

- The tuition fee payable as notified by the Government of Telangana in G.O.Ms.No. 106, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 28.07.2023 and G.O.Ms.No. 132, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 18.08.2023 (for Deccan College of Medical Sciences).
- 2. For Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences: Tuition Fee is Rs. 15 lakhs per annum for B Category and Rs. 22.5 lakhs per annum for C/NRI category as per G.O.Ms.No. 40, Higher Education (UE) Dept., Dated: 20.06.2023.

NOTE: Out of the total enhanced MBBS seats, 50% of seats are shown under Competent Authority Quota (CQ). Remaining 50% seats are shown under Management Quota (MQ). Enhanced seats in Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences are shown under Management Quota (MQ).

- 2. In accordance with the G.O.Ms.No. 130, HM&FW (C1) Dept., Dated: 27.09.2022, in Management Quota B category, 85% of seats are reserved for local candidates of Telangana and 15% of seats are open to candidates from all over the country. 15% unreserved seats shall be allotted first followed by seats reserved for local candidates in Management Quota B Category seats.
- 3. The MBBS seats in Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences are distributed in accordance with the "Telangana State Private Universities (Establishment and Regulation) Act", Act no. 11 of 2018.
- 4. The allotment of seats will be made in accordance with the selection procedure notified in Government orders G.O.Ms.No. 115 &116, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 05.07.2017, G.O.Ms.No. 117 & 118 HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 20.07.2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No. 130, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 27-09-2022, G.O. Ms. No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 19-07-2024, G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble High Court/Supreme court orders and University regulations.
- 5. Candidates are informed that they will be considered only to the category/categories to which they have registered. (B& C/NRI)
- 6. Candidates in the final merit list are informed that if they do not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, they are not eligible to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counselling to prevent seat blocking.

7. Admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw/discontinue from the course after Mop Up phase of counselling. Admitted candidates will have to pay discontinuation penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs as per Government orders, if they discontinue the course after the Mop Up phase of counselling to get their original certificates back. Candidates will also be debarred for 3 years for MBBS admission under KNRUHS to prevent seat blocking.

### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

- Eligible NEET-UG-2025 qualified candidates as per final merit list for Management Quota can exercise web options for MBBS/BDS courses in the affiliated Medical/Dental colleges of KNRUHS and Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences as per their interest and priority through <a href="https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/">https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/</a> from computer with internet connection.
- Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus for the Regulations for admission into MBBS/BDS courses under Management Quota (B & C/NRI category) and Government Orders on Rules of Admission on KNRUHS website before exercising web-options.
- 3. If a candidate is allotted a seat in MBBS/BDS course as per his/her options and does not join the course, penalty clause shall be applicable including penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs and debarment for 3 years to prevent seat blocking. If candidates are not interested to join in any college, they should not exercise weboptions for the same.
- 4. Candidates exercising web-options for MBBS/BDS courses are informed that there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options. Candidates can exercise web options for any number of courses/colleges the candidate is interested to join as per candidate's eligibility (B & C/NRI category) in order of preference.
- 5. Candidates are advised to exercise web options for MBBS/BDS seats in all colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of available vacant seats shown in seat matrix, as vacancies will arise during counselling process due to sliding of candidates from allotted seats in second phase of counselling to other seats as per their web-options in the second phase of counselling.
- 6. If a seat is allotted in this phase of counselling as per web-options exercised by the candidates in this phase of counselling, the seat allotted in previous phase of counselling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore, candidates are informed to exercise web-options carefully for sliding with awareness of this fact.

- 7. Candidates in the final merit list are informed that if they do not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, they are not eligible to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.
- 8. Management Quota seats (B & C/NRI) in Private Minority Medical Colleges are reserved for Muslim Minority candidates only. In case Muslim Minority Candidates are not available, the seats may be filled up with Non-Minority students up to maximum of 30% during final phase of counselling.
- 9. Allotment of Management Quota seats in Army College of Dental Sciences is reserved for the wards of Army personnel as per AWES regulations.
- 10. Candidates have to exercise web-options for B category and if eligible for C/NRI in order of their priority for college. Allotments will be made according to the order of preference in the web options exercised by the candidate.
- 11. One time pass word will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of exercising web-options. The pass word consists of SIX letter code with English capital A to Z. (For details read construction to the candidates before giving options)
- 12. Candidates are instructed to take a print out of saved options.
- 13. Candidates will receive SMS message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if allotted. Candidates are also informed to login to check their allotment status on <a href="https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/">https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/</a> website after each phase of counseling.
- 14. The selected candidates shall download the allotment order from the website after payment of the University fee by gateway method by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates should check their allotment and report to the Principal of respective Medical College on or before the date specified in the allotment order.
- 15. Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the respective Medical/Dental College before the last date for joining as specified on the allotment order, submit all original certificates, relevant bonds and pay the tuition fee/college fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the admission process within specified date for joining, the admission will be cancelled automatically and penalty clause shall be applicable with a penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs and debarment for 3 years to prevent seat blocking.

- 16. If the candidate slides to other college during Mop Up phase of counselling, the original certificates will be sent to the college concerned after the closure of admissions. Candidates have to get relieved from previous phase joined college, obtain custodian certificate, collect fees and report to the Principal of allotted college before last date of joining. Admitted candidates shall not be permitted to discontinue from the course after allotment in Mop Up phase of counselling.
- 17. Candidates are hereby informed that final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the allotted Medical/Dental College and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University regulations.
- 18. Candidates allotted seat under NRI quota should produce the relevant sponsorship letter from NRI relative in original along with a copy of Passport/Residence proof/Bank Statement or Pass book of sponsor for NRI category at respective colleges.
- 19. Original certificates submitted at the time of admissions shall not be returned to the candidate, unless the candidate discontinues the course.
- 20. Admitted candidates will have to pay discontinuation penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs as per Government orders, if they discontinue the course after free exit to get back their original certificates.
- 21. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

#### NOTE:

If any discrepancies are found during the verification of documents or at any stage including after closure of admission, admissions of such candidates will be cancelled and action will be initiated including lodging of Criminal Case before the appropriate authority. The candidate / Parent / Guardian are only held responsible for any wrong claim against NRI Quota admission.
