# MBBS ADMISSIONS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

# NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB-OPTIONS FOR STRAY VACANCY PHASE OF <u>COUNSELING</u>

In continuation to this office notifications dated: 15.07.2025, 25.07.2025, 08.09.2025, 12.09.2025, 15.09.2025, 25.09.2025 & 25.10.2025, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences hereby notifies to conduct the Stray Vacancy phase of web-based counseling for vacant seats under Competent Authority Quota (CQ) for admission into MBBS course for the AY 2025-26 in Private Un-aided Non-Minority & Minority Medical Colleges in the State of Telangana.

All the eligible candidates whose names are displayed in the final merit list on KNRUHS website can exercise web options for admission into MBBS course from 10.00 AM on 16.11.2025 up to 10.00 AM on 17.11.2025 through website <a href="https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/">https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/</a> subject to the following conditions;

- 1. The Candidates who were allotted seats in the previous phases of counselling under Competent Authority Quota are not eligible for exercising options.
- 2. Candidates who have not exercised web options in the first phase of counselling are not eligible to exercise web options.
- 3. Candidates who have joined MBBS course under Management Quota in the previous phases of counselling and continuing in the course are not eligible to exercise weboptions.
- 4. Candidates who have joined BDS course under Competent Authority Quota and Management Quota in the previous phases and continuing in the course are not eligible to exercise web-options.
- 5. Candidates who are admitted under MCC counselling up to third phase of counselling as notified on MCC website are not eligible to exercise web-options.
- 6. Candidates who have discontinued the course after joining in previous phases of counselling are not eligible to exercise web-options.
- 7. Options of candidates who are admitted in other states as per the data uploaded to MCC

portal shall not be considered.

8. Options of candidates who are allotted seats in the Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling shall not be considered.

For eligibility criteria and regulations refer to notifications dated: 15.07.2025.

**UNIVERSITY FEE:** Allotted Candidates have to pay University fee of Rs. 12,000/- for MBBS Course through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and download the allotment order.

**TUITION FEE:** Tuition fee is to be paid at respective Medical Colleges.

The tuition fee payable as notified by the Government of Telangana.

#### **NOTE:**

- 1. The details of vacant seats available for stray vacancy phase of counselling are placed in the University website <a href="http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in">http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in</a>. Candidates can exercise web options for MBBS seats through <a href="https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/">https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/</a>.
- 2. The allotment of seats will be made in accordance with the selection procedure notified in Government orders G.O.Ms.No. 114, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 05.07.2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No. 75, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 04-07-2023, G.O. Ms. No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 19-07-2024, G.O.Ms.No. 10, Scheduled Castes Development (POA.A2) Department, Dated: 14.04.2025, G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble High Court/Supreme court orders and University regulations.
- 3. Admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw/discontinue from the course after Stray vacancy phase of counselling.

#### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

1. Eligible NEET-UG-2025 qualified candidates as per final merit list for Competent Authority Quota subject to the above mentioned conditions can exercise web options for MBBS course into vacant MBBS seats as per their interest and priority through

- https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/ from computer with internet connection.
- Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus for the Regulations for admission into MBBS course and Government Orders on Rules of Admission on KNRUHS website before exercising web-options.
- 3. Admitted candidates will have to pay discontinuation penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs as per Government Orders, if they discontinue the course after the Mop Up/Stray Vacancy phase of counselling to get their original certificates back. Candidates also will be debarred for 3 years for MBBS admission under KNRUHS to prevent seat blocking.
- 4. If a candidate is allotted a seat in MBBS course as per his/her web-options in this phase and does not join the course, penalty clause shall be applicable including penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs and debarment for 3 years to prevent seat blocking.
- 5. One time pass word will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of exercising web-options. The pass word consists of SIX letter code with English capital A to Z. (For details read instructions to the candidates before giving options).
- 6. Candidates are instructed to take a print out of saved options.
- 7. Candidates will receive SMS message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat. Candidates are also informed to login to check their allotment status on <a href="https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/">https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/</a> website after each phase of counseling.
- 8. The selected candidates shall download the allotment order from the website after payment of the University fee by gateway method by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates should check their allotment and report to the Principal of respective Medical College on or before the date specified on the allotment order.
- 9. Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the respective Medical College before the last date for joining as specified in the allotment order, to submit all original certificates, relevant bonds and to pay the tuition fee/college fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the admission process within specified date for joining, the admission will be cancelled automatically and penalty clause shall be applicable including penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs and debarment for 3 years to prevent seat blocking.
- 10. Candidates are hereby informed that final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the allotted Medical College and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated against the candidate & parent as per University regulations.
- 11. Original certificates submitted at the time of admissions shall not be returned to the

candidate, unless the candidate discontinues the course.

### 12. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
