This notification is issued for registration of the candidates to appear for Second BNYS Part I Supplementary examinations commencing from **20.01.2026**.

1) Eligibility to appear for Second BNYS Part I Supplementary Examinations:

The BNYS students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2022-23 whose admissions are approved by the University and completed study period with 75% attendance (both theory & practical separately) and 35% of internal assessment marks in each subject and also the students of previous batches who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examinations conducted earlier are eligible to appear for the examinations in January 2026 subject to the course regulations.

- 2) The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the students is up to **17.12.2025**.
- 3) The uploading of attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the students is from **22.12.2025 to 24.12.2025**.
- 4) The confirmation date for uploaded attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the students is on **27.12.2025**.

Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:

The University is a digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For BNYS course, single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.

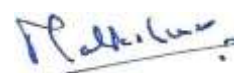
