# SECOND MBBS (NEW REGULATIONS) SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS NOTIFICATION, JANUARY 2026

**Sub:-** KNRUHS – Exams – Conducting of Second MBBS (New Regulations) Supplementary Examinations in the month of January 2026 – Issue of Notification – Regarding.

This notification is issued for registration of the candidates to appear for Second MBBS (New Regulations) Supplementary Examinations commencing from **20.01.2026**.

# 1) <u>Eligibility to appear for Second MBBS (New Regulations) Supplementary Examinations:</u>

The MBBS students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2023-24 whose admissions are approved by the University and also students of previous batches who have failed, detained or not registered for the said examinations conducted earlier are eligible to appear for the examinations in January 2026 subject to the course regulations.

- 2) The Second MBBS students who are having minimum **75% ATTENDANCE IN THEORY AND 80% ATTENDANCE IN PRACTICAL/CLINICAL** in each subject and scored minimum **50% (FIFTY PERCENT)** marks in internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- 3) The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the students is up to 12.12.2025.
- 4) The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the students is from **18.12.2025** to **20.12.2025**.
- 5) The confirmation date for uploaded attendance and internal assessment marks is on 23.12.2025.

# <u>Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:</u>

The University is a digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For MBBS course, single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.

2) **Criteria for passing in a subject:** A candidate shall obtain 50% marks in aggregate and 60:40 (minimum) or 40:60 (minimum) in University conducted examination separately in Theory and in Practical (practical includes; practical/clinical and viva voce) in order to be declared as passed in that subject.
