Ref:- Orders of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

This notification is issued for registration of the candidates to appear for Final MBBS Part I (New Regulations) Supplementary Examinations commencing from **07.04.2026**.

Eligibility to appear for Final MBBS Part I (New Regulations) Supplementary Examinations:

- 1) The MBBS students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year **2022-23** whose admissions are approved by the University and students who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examinations conducted earlier are eligible to appear for the examinations subject to NMC Regulations.**
- 2) The Final MBBS Part I students who are having minimum **75% ATTENDANCE IN THEORY AND 80% ATTENDANCE IN PRACTICAL/CLINICAL** in each subject and scored minimum **50% (FIFTY PERCENT)** marks in internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.**
- 3) The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the candidates is up to **25.02.2026**.**
- 4) The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the candidates is from **02.03.2026** to **04.03.2026**.**
- 5) The confirmation date for uploaded attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the candidates is on **07.03.2026**.**

Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:

The University is a digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For MBBS course, single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.
