With references to the above, it is to inform that the Government of Telangana has issued orders from time to time regarding the fixation and collection of tuition fee for MBBS and BDS courses in Government and Private Medical Colleges. Though instructions were issued earlier, complaints are still being received. Therefore, this communication is issued in continuation of the previous letter vide reference 6th cited.

As per G.O.Ms.No.106, HM&FW (C1) Department, dated 28.07.2023, the tuition fee shall be collected strictly in accordance with the Government orders. The total course fee shall be collected for **4½ years** at the beginning of each academic year **in five (05) installments**, for strict compliance with the said G.O and by following instructions issued by TAFRC (Copies enclosed).

In this regard, it is brought to the notice of the University that some medical colleges are causing inconvenience to students, particularly those admitted under Management Quota, by misinterpreting the above orders and insisting on incorrect fee payments. This is resulting in undue hardship and mental stress to the students.

Further, as per the TAFRC Press Release dated 26.06.2024, the fee has been fixed for the block period 2023–2026, wherein it is clearly mentioned that the total course fee shall be in **five installments**.

Subsequently, TAFRC has also issued a clarification reiterating that the fee shall be calculated for 4½ years and collected in five installments accordingly.

In view of the above, it is informed that insisting on collection of total fee for **5 years** is improper and in violation of the Government Orders and TAFRC guidelines. Any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously. If any student is subjected to harassment, the University will take stringent action, including initiation of proceedings for cancellation of affiliation against of such colleges.

Therefore, all the Principals/Deans of Private Medical& Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS are hereby directed to strictly follow the above instructions without any deviation.

ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, orders were issued for fixation of fee structure for MBBS and BDS courses for the remaining block period of 2021-2023 for the private unaided non-minority/minority medical and dental colleges in the State and also the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad.

2. In the reference 2nd read above, Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (TAFRC) has submitted proposal for fixation of fee structure for MBBS and BDS courses for the block period of 2023-2026 for the private unaided non-minority / minority medical and dental colleges in the State.

3. Government after examination of the matter, hereby accept the recommendations of the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee and fix the fee structure for MBBS and BDS courses for the block period 2023-2026 as appended to this order as Annexure-I & II for the private unaided non-minority/minority medical and dental colleges in the state and also the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad.

4. The following conditions shall be followed by all the private unaided non-minority / minority medical and dental colleges in the state:-

(i) The management shall not charge any capitation fee and there shall not be any profiteering. Except the above fee fixed by the Committee, no other amount, either directly or indirectly, can be charged un-authorizedly or illegally by the management. If any such other amount is charged under any other head or guise (e.g. donation etc.) it would amount to charging of capitation fee. The surplus (profit) that is generated from the collection of the fee must be for the benefit of the institution and cannot be diverted for other purposes or for personal gain.

(ii) The total fee of the course shall be collected at the beginning of every academic year and in five installments.

(iii) The same fee shall continue for the students admitted during the block period of 2023-26 till they complete the course.

(iv) The managements of the institutions may seek bank guarantee for tuition fee chargeable for every succeeding year.

5. The Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences, Warangal, the Principals of all the private unaided non-minority / minority medical and dental colleges in the State and also Principal of Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.



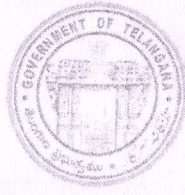

## PRESS RELEASE


During the A.Y. 2016 – 2017, and 2017 – 2018, Government issued orders vide G.O.Ms.No.126, dated 12.09.2016 and G.O.Ms.No.120, dated 20.07.2017 indicating that the **"Tuition Fee is payable annually for five academic years" and also continue to pay every year same annual fee at the rate of existing at the time of their admission till they complete their course"**. Later, Government has decided to retain the existing fee for the A.Y. 2020 – 2021 for UG Medical & Dental Course in view of special circumstances due to COVID-19 pandemic.

During the A.Y. 2021 – 2023, Government on the basis of recommendations of TAFRC issued orders vide G.O.Ms.No.05, dated 27.01.2022 indicating "The total fee of the course (4 ½ years) shall be collected at the beginning of every academic year and in five installments". Therefore, the fee fixed for MBBS Courses shall be collected for 4 ½ years (9 semesters) only at the beginning of every academic year and in five equal instalments. The same was also clarified to all Private Medical Colleges vide this office letter dated 16.11.2022 that the fee fixed would be for 4 ½ years which can be collected in five equal instalments. For example: - for a college for which a fee of Rs.14.50 Lakhs fixed, the total fee comes to Rs.65.25 Lakhs per course (4 ½ years) which can be collected at the beginning of every academic year and in five equal instalments which comes to Rs.13.05 Lakhs per annum.

It is also clarified that the fee fixed by this committee for the entire MBBS course which is spread over 4 ½ years and divided into 9 semesters, to reduce the burden on students, the same is divided into 5 equal instalments for 4 ½ years course. The committee recommends that the fee shall be collected at the beginning of each academic year in five equal instalments and managements shall not collect the fee in advance.

It is also clarified that the candidates who were detained / failed during their course, and continued, no fee shall be collected from the candidates as they had already paid the fees for that academic year.

Therefore, all the Private Medical Colleges are hereby directed to follow the same.
