**PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO MBBS/BDS COURSES UNDER
COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27**

The following are the Regulations for admission into MBBS/BDS Courses in all Medical and Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS for the academic year 2026-27 under Competent Authority Quota i.e., the seats in Government Medical/Dental Colleges (after exclusion of 15 % seats transferred to All India Quota) and Category 'A' seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority / Minority Medical Colleges and Private Non-Minority Dental Colleges and Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad.

NUMBER OF SEATS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA:

The number of MBBS & BDS seats under Competent Authority Quota for the AY 2026-27 in Government Medical & Dental Colleges, Un-aided Private Non-Minority & Minority Medical Colleges, Un-aided Private Non-Minority Dental Colleges and Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad will be as permitted by NMC/NDC and shall be notified before counselling.

The tuition fee for the academic year 2026–27 shall be as per the Orders to be issued by the Government of Telangana.

The seat matrix for Competent Authority Quota seats for the AY 2026-27 will be displayed in the university website before exercising web-options for counselling.

In case of new MBBS/BDS seats permitted by NMC/NDC in the Medical & Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS for the AY 2026-27, shall be added in the subsequent phases of counselling.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

In accordance with NMC Regulations,

the candidate should have passed Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Biotechnology and English.

- OC/EWS candidates should obtain not less than 50% marks in science subjects.
 - BC/SC/ST candidates should obtain not less than 40% marks in science subjects.
 - OC/EWS PWD candidates should obtain not less than 45% marks in science subjects.
- The Candidate should have qualified in NEET UG 2026 as per cut-off scores notified above.

AGE:

The candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2026. The candidates who do not complete 17 years as on 31-12-2026 need not apply for the counselling. The above age criteria are applicable to all candidates of all categories.

CUT-OFF SCORE IN NEET UG 2026

Candidates should have secured the following cut-off score or above in NEET UG 2026 Examination.

ELIGIBILITY:

The candidates, who have qualified in NEET UG 2026 by securing cut-off marks or above have to apply for determining the State Merit position for Competent Authority Quota seats subject to the conditions specified in admission Regulations/Prospectus for the AY 2026-27.

A candidate for admission into Under graduate courses under Competent Authority Quota in Telangana should be Indian Nationals, Person of Indian Origin (PIO) or Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card holders (PIO/OCI status issued before 04-03-2021) and shall fulfil the following provisions in G.O.Ms.No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Date: 19.07.2024 and G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Date: 08.09.2025.

- (i) If the candidate has studied in an Educational Institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

- (ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in Educational Institutions, if he has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

(iii) Local area herein means the State of Telangana. Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the local area as stated at (ii) above, to be eligible for admission into Under graduate courses under Competent Authority Quota, the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana.

- I. Provided that a candidate who studies outside Telangana for any period during the requisite four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination, will be eligible to be considered if they fall under any of the below categories:
 1. Children of employees of the Telangana State Government who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 2. Children of serving or retired officers belonging to the Telangana cadre of All India Services (IAS/IFS/IPS) who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 3. Children of defence personnel/ex-servicemen/Central Armed Police Force service who, at the time of joining service, have declared their hometown to be in the State of Telangana and who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 4. Children of employees of a Corporation/Agency/Instrumentality under Government of Telangana, liable to be transferred anywhere in India as per the terms and conditions of his/her employment, who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
- II. Subject to the candidate submitting certificate of employment from the competent authority for the candidate's father/mother's service outside the State for the period corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.

CANDIDATES WHO ARE DOMICILES OF OTHER STATES OTHER THAN TELANGANA ARE NOT ELIGIBLE AS PER GOVERNMENT ORDERS.

- Admissions will be in accordance with the procedure notified in Rules of Admission vide G.O.Ms.No. 114, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated. 05.07.2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated.22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No 75, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated.04.07.2023, G.O. Ms No.33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated:19.07.2024, G.O. Ms No.150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated:08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble Supreme Court/High Court orders.

- Candidates are advised to carefully read the Prospectus, University Regulations, relevant Government Orders (G.Os.), and the eligibility conditions prescribed in this notification before proceeding with the payment of the Registration and Processing Fee. **The Registration and Processing Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.** Therefore, candidates should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility criteria before making the payment, uploading relevant documents and submitting the online application.

RESERVATION FOR SCHEDULED CASTES (SC):

15% seats under Competent Authority Quota shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes. As per G.O.Ms.No. 10, SCD (POA.A2) Department, Dated: 14.04.2025 and as per Government orders, Dated: 16.05.2025, out of 15% of seats reserved for SC;

SC Group 1	1%
SC Group 2	9%
SC Group 3	5%

RESERVATION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES (ST):

10% seats under Competent Authority Quota shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes as per G.O.Ms.No. 33, Tribal Welfare Department, Dated: 30.09.2022 and as per G.O.Ms.No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 19.07.2024.

Candidates of the Scheduled castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to the State of Telangana for castes which are notified by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be considered for reservations.

RESERVATION FOR BACKWARD CLASSES (BC):

29% seats under Competent Authority Quota shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to Backward classes. As per G.O.Ms.No. 1793, Education Department, Dated: 23.09.1970, G.O.Ms.No. 23, Backward Classes Welfare (C2) Department, Dated: 07.07.2007, G.O.Ms.No. 231, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Department, Dated: 11.07.2007, G.O.Ms.No. 114, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 05.07.2017 and subsequent amendments, out of 29% seats reserved for BC;

BC A	7%
BC B	10%
BC C	1%
BC D	7%
BC E	4%

Candidates of the Backward Classes belonging to the State of Telangana shall be considered for reservations for BC castes, which are notified by the Government of Telangana as Backward classes from time to time.

SOCIAL STATUS CERTIFICATE:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall furnish a latest caste certificate in the prescribed proforma issued by the Competent Authority in support of their claims. The social status of Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes candidates shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.M.s.No.58, SW (J) Dept. Dt. 12-05-1997 and subsequent amendments, Orders of Government of Telangana and orders of Hon'ble High Court.

No candidate seeking reservation for admission under the above categories is eligible under reserved category unless the candidate produces the Integrated Community Certificate prescribed by the Government and issued by the Revenue Authorities in the Government (Vide G.O.Ms.No. 58, Social Welfare (J) Department, dated. 12-05-1997). The castes notified by Government of Telangana for implementation of reservations only will be considered.

Social reservation provided for BC, SC & ST candidates in the ratio 29%, 15% & 10% respectively shall be vertical reservation.

MINORITY STATUS CERTIFICATE:

Candidates belonging to Muslim Minority category should furnish a certificate in support of their claim. Competent Authority Quota seats in Un-aided Private Minority Medical Colleges are reserved for Muslim Minority candidates only.

RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION (EWS):

MBBS seats specifically sanctioned for EWS Reservation, permitted by National Medical Commission in 7 Government Medical Colleges are reserved for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category candidates who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for SC, ST & Socially and Educationally Backward Classes. These reservations will be implemented from specially sanctioned seats for implementation of EWS reservations which are exclusively permitted for implementation of EWS reservation by National Medical Commission/Ministry of Health, Government of India in specified in the following 7 Government Medical Colleges (vide GO.Ms. No.47, HM&FW (C1), Department, Dated 21.06.2019);

1. Gandhi Medical College, Secunderabad
2. Kakatiya Medical College, Hanamkonda
3. Government Medical College, Siddipet
4. Government Medical College, Mahabubnagar
5. Government Medical College, Nizamabad
6. Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Adilabad
7. ESIC Medical College, Hyderabad

Candidates claiming reservation under EWS Category shall obtain the relevant latest EWS certificate valid for 2026-27 for reservation under economically weaker section issued by Tahsildar, who is the Competent Authority in state of Telangana for issue of EWS Certificates.

RESERVATION FOR WOMEN CANDIDATES:

33⅓% of the seats are guaranteed for women candidates in each category. This regulation of guarantee shall not be applicable if women candidates are selected on merit in each category for 33⅓% or more of the seats therein.

HORIZONTAL RESERVATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

The following special category reservations are applicable under Competent Authority Quota MBBS/BDS seats;

Children of Armed Personnel (CAP)	1%
Persons with Disabilities (PWD)	5%
Police Martyrs Children (PMC)	0.25%

RESERVATION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWD) CANDIDATES:

- The guidelines of Government of India and latest regulations of National Medical Commission/Medical Council of India shall be followed in making admissions of Persons With Disabilities (PWD).
- The candidate seeking admission under PWD reservation should apply under PWD Category in online application.
- The Medical Board shall be constituted by the University as per G.O.Ms.No. 114, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 05.07.2017 to assess the percentage of disability as per Medical Council of India/National Medical Commission latest regulations. Candidates claiming reservation under PWD quota should present themselves before the Medical Board constituted by the University for evaluation of PWD percentage and confirmation of eligibility. **The decision of Medical Board specially constituted for this purpose is final and binding on the candidate.**
- Candidates shall produce the following documents to the Medical Board constituted by the University at the time of physical assessment. **The date of physical assessment shall be notified separately in the University website. Candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly for updates.**
 1. NEET UG 2026 score card
 2. Permanent UDID card issued by the Department of Empowerment of persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) (DEPWD), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India.
 3. Self-certified affidavit declaring his or her functional abilities in the format specified in **Schedule I** which shall be verified by the Medical Assessment Board during the course of assessment.

4. Self-Certification Affidavit specified in **annexure A** and Affidavit specific to the candidate's disability category, in the prescribed format of NMC as provided in **annexure B to F**.

NOTE: In case the UDID Card or Affidavit submitted by the candidate is found to be 'FAKE', the seat of the candidate will be 'CANCELLED' and legal action will be taken against the candidate/parent/guardian.

RESERVATION FOR ANGLO INDIANS:

One (1) BDS seat in Government Dental College, Hyderabad, shall be reserved for Anglo Indian candidate. The candidates shall produce certificate in support of his / her claim in the prescribed proforma issued by Mandal Revenue Officer subject to scrutiny and conformation by the Secretary, Department of Minority Welfare, Government of Telangana.

RESERVATION FOR CHILDREN OF EMPLOYEES OF SINGARENI COLLIERIES COMPANY LIMITED:

Out of 150 MBBS seats of Government Medical College, Ramagundam / Singareni Institute of Medical Sciences, 5% of the 127 seats under Competent Authority Quota (after deducting 23 seats of All India Quota) rounded up to Seven (7) seats shall be reserved for children of employees of Singareni Collieries Company Limited. SC, ST, BC category reservations shall be applicable and allotment will be based on NEET UG 2026 Merit in respective categories. The candidate shall produce a certificate in support of his/her claim from the Managing Director, Singareni Collieries Company Limited to avail this reservation".

GRACE MARKS FOR NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC):

- NCC cadets (who have obtained NCC certificates prior to qualifying exam i.e. intermediate or its equivalent), who have qualified NEET UG 2026 and who have applied for admission, shall be provided with grace marks to be added to NEET score as follows (As per G.O.MS.No. 75, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated. 04.07.2026):

- The Director, NCC, Telangana shall depute officers to the verification centre as per the requisition from Registrar, KNRUHS, Warangal. The verification officers shall submit candidate wise verified certificates list to the Registrar, KNRUHS. **The decision of verification officers is final with respect to verification of above certificates.**

KNRUHS will prepare merit list after addition of grace marks as per the verified data submitted by the Directorate of NCC.

SCHEDULE FOR REGISTRATION THROUGH ONLINE AND UPLOADING OF ALL RELEVANT CERTIFICATES:

Candidates can register online and upload scanned original certificates on the website <https://tsmedadm.tsche.in> from **06.00 AM** on **05.08.2026** up to **06.00 PM** on **12.08.2026**.

Provisional Merit position of the registered candidates will be prepared based on the NEET UG 2026 rank and other eligibility criteria notified, after verification of scanned original certificates. Final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission at allotted college by the admission committee of the college.

REGISTRATION AND PROCESSING FEE:

- Candidates are advised to carefully read the Prospectus, University Regulations, relevant Government Orders (G.Os.), and the eligibility conditions prescribed in this notification before proceeding with the payment of the Registration and Processing Fee. **The Registration and Processing Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.** Therefore, candidates should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility criteria before making the payment, uploading relevant documents and submitting the online application.
- The Registration and Processing fee is as follows;

OC & BC candidates	Rs. 4,000/- (Bank transaction charges extra)

*Fee shall be paid online through Debit Card/Credit Card or Net Banking.

NOTE: Registration & Processing fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to a further date.

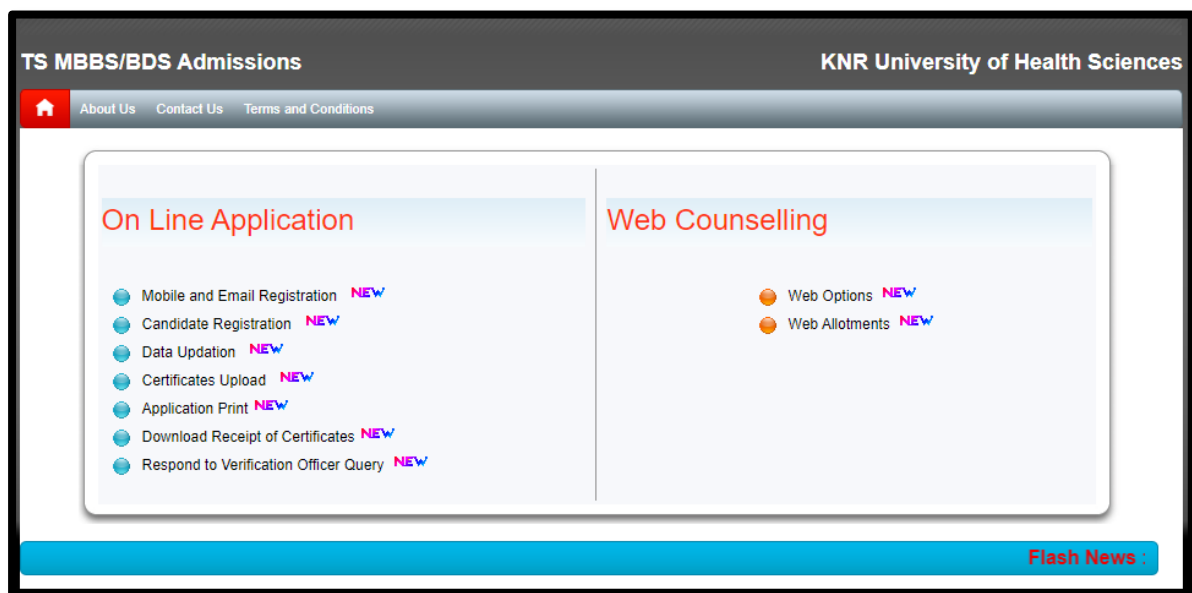
- The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required for through computer with internet connection.
- The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates, Scanned Photo and Signature in the jpg/.gif format separately and ready to enter his/her correct data and upload the photo, signature and original certificates, after the payment of application fee through Online.

PROCEDURE FOR PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION AND PROCESSING FEE AND FILLING ONLINE APPLICATION:

The following are the four steps to register for MBBS/BDS admissions under Competent Authority Quota for the AY 2026-27;

- **Mobile and Email Registration**
(Mobile and Email registration is to be done only once, if it is successfully completed).
- **Candidate Registration and Payment of Registration and Processing Fee**
(If payment is successful, you will receive registration number to your mobile and email. Need not repeat this step again if you receive registration number).
- **Uploading of data**
(You can edit data any number of times till the verification process starts).
- **Uploading of certificates**
(You can edit data any number of times till the verification process starts).



After entering into the website, follow the following steps for payment of registration and processing fee and for submitting the application form online for registration for admission into MBBS/BDS courses under Competent Authority Quota for the AY 2026-27.

- Click on the Mobile and Email Registration. The candidate should have a valid /working Mobile and Email Id. OTP will be sent to registered Mobile and Email Id at different stages. The candidate should keep the Mobile and Email Id active till completion of the counselling process. 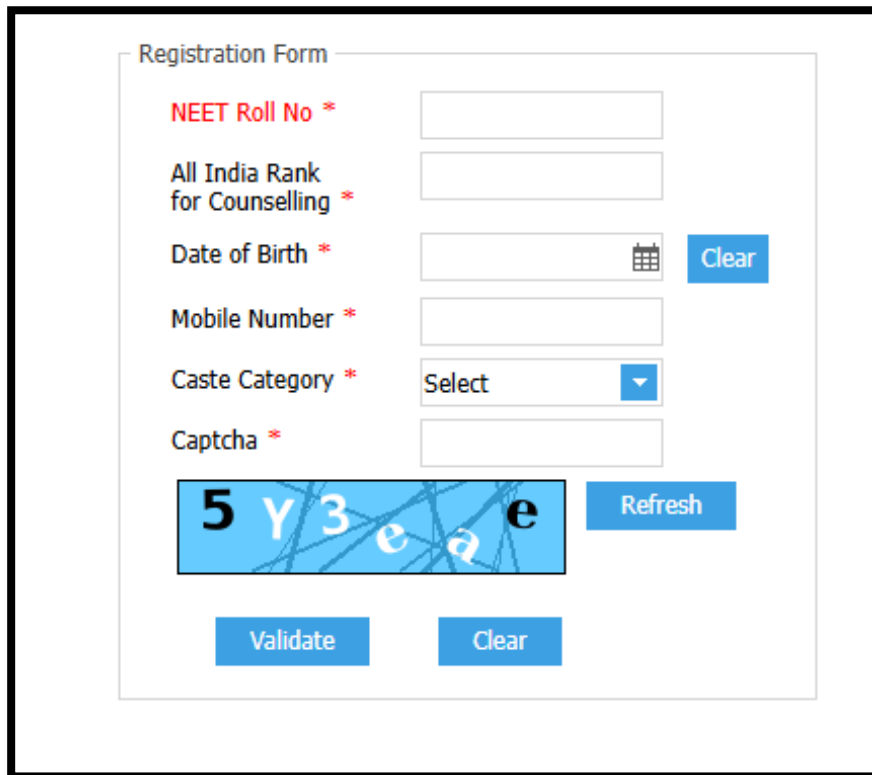

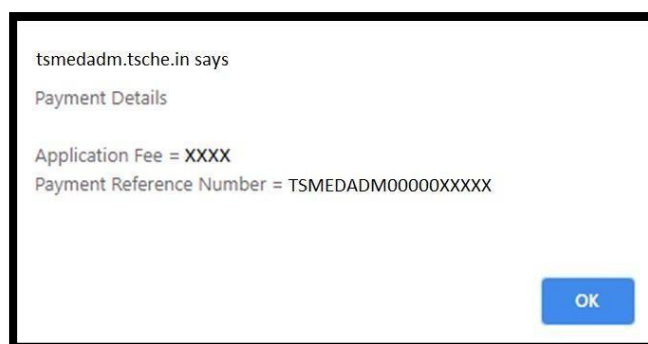

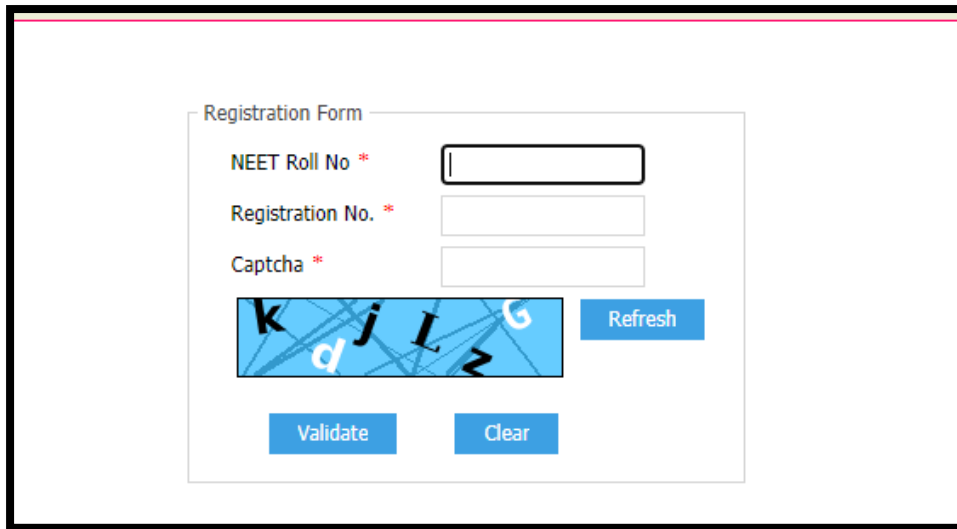

Ms No.33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated:19.07.2024, G.O. Ms No.150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated:08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble Supreme Court/High Court orders.
- Candidates have to exercise web options for seats in the interested colleges for MBBS course and BDS course separately. Candidates and parents are informed to exercise web options very carefully in order of their preference for colleges and also to take a print out of exercised web options which are uploaded for reference.
- The Admission Committee shall have power to review the admission in case of any errors, misrepresentation and can cancel the admission. In all matters relating to admissions, the decision of the Admission Committee shall be final and binding on the candidates and admissions cannot be questioned after closure of admissions.

ADMISSION RULES:

- The provisional allotment order of the candidate can be downloaded from website after payment of University fee by payment gateway. The candidate should submit the printout of the filled in Online application form, allotment order and original certificates along with one set of self-attested copies to the Principal of allotted college at the time of joining for final verification by the admission committee constituted at concerned college. The admission committee is responsible for scrutiny of the original certificates submitted by the candidate. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment order for admission will be cancelled.
- Selected candidates have to join the college within the specified date by submitting all Original Certificates, Bonds, and pay the tuition fee as notified by the Government to complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not report at the allotted college within the specified time and complete the process as described above, the admission will be automatically cancelled.

UNIVERSITY FEE:

Candidates have to pay the University fee of **Rs. 12,000/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand only)** through online by payment gateway and obtain the allotment order.

TUITION FEE:

The tuition fee for the academic year 2026–27 shall be as per the Orders to be issued by the Government of Telangana.

DISCONTINUATION FEE:

Candidates cannot discontinue from the course after notified cut-off date for discontinuation or later. Candidates shall have to submit a bond for an amount of **Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs only)** for the same on 100 rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper, duly signed by the candidate and the parent/guardian. (Proforma is annexed).

SANCTION OF LEAVE BEYOND 3 MONTHS AND TERMINATION OF STUDENTSHIP:

- Every candidate after his/her admission shall attend classes on all working days (Theory, Practicals, Clinicals). If a student absents continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course before 2 years after discontinuation, the candidate's application in the prescribed proforma shall be forwarded to the Registrar with the recommendations of the Principal with requisite fees. If the Vice Chancellor is satisfied with the reasons for absence, the candidate may be granted leave of absence and permitted for Re-admission in such conditions as deemed necessary. Candidates who are absent for a continuous period of more than 2 years shall be deemed to have forfeited the admission into the course and the studentship shall stand cancelled without any further notice.
- If the break of study (91 days are more) in more than one spell, the candidate's representation in the prescribed proforma shall be forwarded to Government for appropriate decision in the matter with the specific recommendations of the Executive Council of the University.

- Candidates who are absent for cumulative period of more than (2) years, shall be deemed to have forfeited the admission in to the course and the studentship stands cancel without any further notice.
- The candidate has to pass the final examination for award of Degree for the course within double the duration of study period for the course or within the maximum period permitted by the National Medical Commission from time to time.
- On Re-admission the study period for the course shall be extended equivalent to the period of absence and the candidate shall be eligible to appear for final examination after completion of the extended study period for the course.

COLLEGE REGULATIONS:

Candidates are required to follow the rules and regulations of the college and should also abide by the regulations of the University. Candidates are informed that their correspondence with the university shall be forwarded by the Principal of college with his remarks (through proper channel) for consideration. Under no circumstances they should have any correspondence with higher authorities directly without prior permission of the Principal.

CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

The closure of admissions is as per the schedule notified by the University in accordance with the schedule issued by Medical Counselling Committee/National Medical Commission/National Dental Commission.

COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The course shall commence as per the schedule notified by National Medical Commission/Dental Council of India/Medical Counselling Committee. The duration of the course shall be calculated from the date of commencement of the course and shall be uniform for all the candidates irrespective of individual dates of admission.

POWERS OF THE PRINCIPALS:

Not with standing anything contained in these regulations, the Principals of Medical Colleges in the State may at any time before completion of the Under Graduate course either on his own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of the receipt of the show cause notice to submit a written explanation and or on a personal hearing, order the cancellation of admission to the course, if in his opinion, such candidate had furnished incorrect particulars or false information in the application form or in the documents attached thereto or in the Statements made either before the authority In-charge of admissions or the Principal or any other manner. Against any such order of the Principal, an appeal shall lie to the Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences, Telangana.

POWERS OF THE UNIVERSITY:

KNR University of Health Sciences, may either suo moto or on an application made to them, call for and examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof in respect of the admission made by the concerned authority, for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness of legality or propriety of such selection or cancellation and pass such order in relation thereto as they deem fit including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made, provided that the University may, before cancelling such selection or admission, give an opportunity to the authority and to the person affected to show cause against such cancellation. University has every right to cancel the admission of any candidate without any notice, if the certificates produced by the candidate are found to be fake /false/forged.

DISCIPLINE:

The students shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training program. The candidates shall not resort to any strikes during the period of their study.
