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ORDER:

In the circumstances reported by the Registrar, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana, Warangal in the Letter 9th read above, Government after careful consideration of the matter hereby issue the following orders for admission into Post Graduate AYUSH Courses for seats in Private Non Minority AYUSH Colleges in view of the introduction of All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIAPGET) based admissions, guidelines for counselling as per National Commission for Homeopathy Regulations and the guidelines issued by Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India.

2. The following notification shall be published in an Extraordinary issue of the Telangana Gazette Dated:29.06.2022.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 and 15 of the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (Act No: 5 of 1983), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following Rules for admission into the Post Graduate Professional Courses of AYUSH in Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions in the State:-

RULES

1. Short title, applicability and commencement:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Telangana State Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions (Regulation of Admissions into Post Graduate AYUSH Professional Courses) Rules, 2021.
- (2) They shall apply to all Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions imparting Post Graduate Professional Education in AYUSH courses for which admissions shall be made to the "Competent Authority Quota seats", and "Management Quota seats" in such manner as prescribed herein.

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- (3) These Rules shall come into force from the Academic Year 2021-22.

2. Definitions:-

- (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
- i) "Act" means the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (Act No. 5 of 1983);
 - ii) "Competent Authority" means the Vice Chancellor, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana State, Warangal (KNRUHS);
 - iii) "Committee for Admissions" means the Committee nominated by the Competent Authority to select and make allotment of candidates to Competent Authority Quota Seats and Management Quota seats in Professional Institutions offering P.G. AYUSH Courses in the State for Admissions in accordance with the rules laid down;
 - iv) "Common Entrance Test" means, All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIAPGET) which will be the basis for admission of the candidates into the Post Graduate AYUSH Courses concerned in various Un-aided Non-Minority AYUSH Institutions in the State;
 - v) "Competent Authority Quota Seats (Convener Quota)" means the seats earmarked from out of the permitted/recognized intake of seats in each course and in each college to be filled combined with PG seats in Government AYUSH colleges by the Committee for Admissions;
 - vi) "Management Quota Seats" means the seats earmarked from out of the permitted/recognized intake of seats in each course to be filled in such manner as prescribed by the Government by the Committee for Admissions constituted;
 - vii) "Institutions" means, unless otherwise specifically mentioned, all the Unaided Non-Minority Professional Institutions imparting Post Graduate Education in AYUSH courses;
 - viii) "Qualified Candidate" in respect of all the seats to be filled by the Competent Authority means the candidate who has qualified in the AIAPGET for Post Graduate course admissions and has been assigned merit ranking in the Common merit list;
 - ix) "Qualifying Examination" means the examination of the minimum qualification prescribed which entitles one to seek admission into the relevant Professional Post Graduate AYUSH Course after getting eligibility in AIAPGET exam.
- (2) Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (Act No. 5 of 1983) unless otherwise defined by the Government in Health Medical and Family Welfare Department or by the Competent Authority.

(3) Seat Sharing and Admissions:

- (i) The total seats permitted/recognized by National Commission for Homeopathy in private AYUSH institutions are allotted through Counselling as follows.
- (ii) The AYUSH Post Graduate seats in private institutions are distributed as 50% Competent Authority Quota seats and 50% Management Quota seats.
- (iii) If there is only one seat available in the specialty, the seat shall be allotted to Management Quota for the year 2021-22 and subsequently to Convener Quota in the year 2022-23. The allotment shall be alternated in the subsequent years.
- (iv) If there are two seats available in the specialty, one seat shall be allotted to Management Quota and one seat shall be allotted to Convener Quota.
- (v) Similarly, If there are 3 seats in a specialty, one seat shall be allotted to the Convener Quota and one seat shall be allotted to Management Quota and the remaining seat shall be allotted to the Management Quota in the year 2021-22 and subsequently to Convener quota in the year 2022-23. The allotment of third seat shall be alternated in the subsequent years.
- (vi) Similar distribution of seats shall be followed for more number of seats.
- (vii) From 50% Competent Authority Quota seats, 15% of total seats in private AYUSH colleges are allotted to All India Quota and Counselling for these seats shall be conducted separately by Counselling Authority of the State i.e., KNRUHS following the guidelines issued by Ministry of AYUSH vide reference 7th read above.
- (viii) The remaining 35% of seats from the 50% Competent Authority Quota seats course wise (out of total intake available in each of the private AYUSH Colleges), are clubbed with PG seats in Government AYUSH colleges and are allotted by the KNRUHS AYUSH PG Committee for Admission through counselling. Allocation of seats is based on merit as per ranking assigned by the Competent Authority based on All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIAPGET) , as the case may be, and in accordance with the rules framed by State Government for the purpose.
- (ix) The seat matrix regarding the Convener & Management Quota seats in each Post Graduate Specialty course in each AYUSH College shall be prepared by the University every year before counselling. Any additional seats permitted by National Commission for Homeopathy and the University will be included in the Counselling process.
- (x) The unfilled seats after Mop-Up phase of Counselling for Competent Authority seats shall be reverted to Management of respective Colleges. If a candidate is allotted a seat in Mop-Up phase of Counselling of the Convener Quota and fails to join the course at allotted Private College, that seat can be filled by the Management of respective Institutions with eligible candidates from the Management Quota merit list notified by KNRUHS.

- (xi) 50% of the permitted/recognized intake of the seats designated as Management Quota in Private AYUSH institutions shall be filled by the "Committee for Admissions", with nominee from AYUSH college as one of its member, under the categories listed hereunder with the eligible candidates on the basis of inter se merit among the applicants qualified in AIAPGET.
- Management Quota- Sub category 1:- 25% of the permitted/recognized intake of seats, course wise, in each of member institutions shall be filled by the candidates in General Merit based on the AIAPGET ranking
 - Management Quota- Subcategory 2:- 15% seats out of total intake of permitted/recognized seats course wise, in each member institution shall be filled by NRI/NRI sponsored candidates on the basis of inter se merit among the applicants qualified in AIAPGET. In case of Non availability of NRI/NRI sponsored candidates, the seats can be allotted to candidates notified in the Management Quota merit list with the notified Tuition fee of sub category 2.
 - Management Quota- Subcategory 3:- 10% seats out of total intake of permitted/recognized seats course wise, in each member institution shall be institutional preference/in-service Management Quota seats filled on the basis of inter se merit among the applicants qualified in AIAPGET as nominated by the Management of the institutions.
- (xii) Seat Matrix for Management Quota seats under the 3 sub categories shall be prepared by the Committee for Admissions of KNRUHS following the guidelines issued in G.O.Ms.No.38, HM& FW (C1) Department, Dated: 30.03.2019.
- (xiii) On non-availability of candidates in any of the categories in xi (a), (b), (c) after Mop-Up phase of Counselling, the seats can be filled by the Management from any other eligible candidates from the Management Quota merit list and the fee shall be on par with these category of students admitted under xi (c).
- (xiv) In view of the contribution of 50% of its total available seats in PG AYUSH Courses to Competent Authority Quota, the Government of Telangana hereby exempts the Management of the Private AYUSH colleges from the obligation, if any, of providing for reservations for either SCs, STs, Backward Classes or any other reservations separately in the Management Quota seats. The Private AYUSH institutions need not make separate reservation under 15(5) or Article 371(J) of the Constitution of India.

(4) Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG AYUSH Courses under the Management Quota Seats:

- (1) TS Private AYUSH Colleges Managements shall nominate one member representative to the Committee for Admissions constituted by the Competent authority. The entire process shall be strictly in accordance with the procedure envisaged by Telangana State Government and Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India.
- (2) The Registrar of KNRUHS shall Issue notification in two National Newspapers, calling for online applications from AIAPGET qualified candidates for admission into Management Quota (Sub-

Category 1) and Management Quota (Sub category 2 & 3) in PG AYUSH courses separately. The admission process and number of seats under Management Quota shall be displayed in the KNRUHS Website.

- (3) KNRUHS shall invite Online Applications in the prescribed form from the AIAPGET eligible candidates for participating in Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for seeking admission to the Post Graduate AYUSH Courses under Management Quota (sub-category-1) and (sub-category 2 & 3) separately.
- (4) The Candidates shall pay prescribed Non – Refundable Registration/Verification Fee and Counselling Fee.
- (5) KNRUHS shall prepare a merit list from the eligible candidates who have applied to the Management Quota seats Online in the prescribed form for admission to Post Graduate AYUSH Courses on the basis of merit rank in the AIAPGET-PG examination and after verification of certificates.
- (6) KNRUHS shall notify the merit list on its Website along with the schedule and procedure of Counselling for Management Quota Seats.
- (7) Counselling will be held separately for Management Quota – Sub category 1 and Management Quota – Sub category 2 & 3. Allotment of seats shall be done on the basis of AIAPGET merit rank and options of the candidate for sub category 1 & 2.
- (8) The Management of the college shall send nomination letter for admission into sub category 3 quota seats from eligible AIAPGET qualified candidates from the Management Quota merit list notified by University.
- (9) The selected candidate will be issued provisional allotment order on payment of University fee with direction to report to the Principal of allotted college within the date specified on allotment order.
- (10) If a candidate opts for a seat, is allotted a seat and fails to pay the Tuition fee, college fee and submit original certificates, bond at the respective institution, the seat shall be treated as vacant and shall be filled in the next phase of Counselling.
- (11) If a selected candidate fails to report to the Principal within the stipulated time, the selection and admission of the candidate shall be cancelled automatically and the seat shall be filled in the next phase of Counselling. Candidates who are allotted a seat and does not join in the course shall not be permitted for next phase of Counselling.
- (12) KNRUHS shall notify on its Website, the schedule of 2nd phase of Counselling to fill up the vacant seats if any, after 1st phase of Counselling for Management Quota Seats and Counselling shall be conducted as per the procedure mentioned above.
- (13) KNRUHS shall notify on its Website, the schedule of Mop-Up phase of Counselling to fill up the vacant seats if any, after 2nd phase of Counselling for Management Quota Seats and Counselling shall be conducted as per the procedure mentioned above.

- (14) The Admissions through Counselling into Management Quota seats shall be closed at the end of Mop - Up phase of Counselling and the candidates who are admitted will be considered as the Bonafide Candidates of the respective colleges.
- (15) Candidates who are allotted PG seats in the Mop-Up phase of Counselling shall compulsorily join the course. In case of default, it is considered as seat blocking and they have to pay penalty of Rs.1,00,000-00(Rupees One lakh only) and they shall be debarred from admissions under KNRUHS for 3 years.
- (16) All the candidates joining the PG AYUSH course should execute a bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- value as prescribed, signed by the candidates and parents to ensure completion of the prescribed period of training or in default or any other reason has to pay Rs.1,00,000-00(Rupees One lakh only) or such amount as specified by KNRUHS, Warangal to the KNR University of Health Sciences.
- (17) The Tuition fee and College Fee shall be paid at the time of admission at the allotted college. Candidates shall submit all original certificates and bond to the Principal of allotted college to complete the process of admission.
- (18) The original certificates submitted by the candidates shall not be returned to the candidates till they complete their course of study and appear for University final examination.
- (19) The Candidates are bound by the University Regulations and Government Rules with regard to Admission, Cancellation and Withdrawal from the Course.
- (20) Any grievance as to the determination of candidates merit and entitlement for admissions, cancellation of seats, refund of fees, return of documents etc., the students or the colleges concerned may approach the Admission Committee of KNRUHS.
- (21) KNRUHS shall display the Government orders regarding the fee structure on its website for different categories.
