ORDER:

1. In the letter 6th read above, the Registrar, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana, has proposed certain amendments to Government Orders on admissions to UG AYUSH medical colleges issued vide G.O. 3rd read above in view of the completion of 10 years period after formation of Telangana State and to delete Government Nizamia Tibbi Medical College, Hyderabad and Gandhi Government Naturopathy College, Hyderabad from the State-wide Institutions list to protect the interests of Telangana students.

2. Section 95 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 (Central Act No.6 of 2014) provides that the existing admission quotas in all Government or private, aided or unaided institutions of higher, technical and medical education in so far as they are provided under article 371-D of the Constitution, shall continue as such for a period of ten years during which the existing common admission process shall continue.

3. Consequent upon expiry of the period of ten (10) years provided in section 95 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act 2014, the Government, after careful examination of the matter, have decided to amend the Telangana State AYUSH Regulation of Admissions into Under Graduate AYUSH Professional Courses, Rules, 2017 issued vide G.O. 3rd read above and to delete Government Nizamia Tibbi Medical College, Hyderabad and Gandhi Government Naturopathy college, Hyderabad from the State-wide Institutions list to protect the interests of Telangana students.

4. Accordingly the following notification shall be published in the Telangana Gazette, Dated:05.10.2024.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (Act No.5 of 1983), the Government of Telangana hereby make the following amendments to the Telangana State AYUSH Regulation of Admissions into Under Graduate AYUSH Professional Courses, Rules, 2017 issued vide G.O. Ms.No. 170, HM & FW (E2) Dept, dated 19.09.2017, and as subsequently amended from time to time.

AMENDMENTS

- (1) In the said rules, in sub-rule (i) of Rule - 2, for clause (x) the following shall be substituted namely:-

"Local candidate" means a candidate who fulfils the conditions prescribed in Rule 3 (a) for admission into under graduate AYUSH courses under the competent authority quota in Telangana.

- (2) in Rule 3, for sub-rule (a), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"(a) Nationality & Domicile: A candidate for admission into Undergraduate AYUSH courses under 'Competent Authority Quota' in Telangana should be Indian National/Person of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) card holder and shall fulfill the following conditions:

- (i) The candidate should have studied in the Educational Institutions in the state of Telangana for a period of not less than four (4) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

- (ii) Where during the whole or any part of the (4) four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in Educational Institutions, he should have resided in the state of Telangana for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

- (iii) Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the State of Telangana as stated at (ii) above, to be eligible for admission into Undergraduate AYUSH courses under Competent Authority Quota, the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana."

- (3) in rule 8, sub-rule (d) and (e) shall be deleted.

- (4) Rule 9 shall be deleted.

- (5) Rule 10 shall be deleted.

- (6) Rule 11 shall be deleted.

- (7) in Rule 14,

(i) sub-rules (viii), (ix), (xi) shall be deleted.

(ii) for sub-rule (x) the following shall be substituted namely:-

"Only local candidates shall be eligible for admissions under competent authority quota"

- (8) in Rule 15, sub-rules (u) and (v) shall be deleted.
