ORDER:

The Registrar, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana State in his letter 4th read above inter-alia has proposed some amendments to the Rules of Admissions into Post Graduate broad speciality courses offered in Government, private non minority and private minority medical colleges in the competent authority quota as notified in G.Os 1st cited, in view of the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court vide reference 2nd cited, MCC notice vide reference 3rd cited and as per the recommendations of Committee Constituted to prevent seat blocking.

2. Government after careful examination of the matter have decided to amend the Telangana Medical Colleges (Admissions into Post Graduate Medical Courses) Rules, 2021 issued in G.Os. 1st read above.
3. Accordingly the following notification will be published in the Telangana Gazette Dated: 25.08.2022.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act 1983 (Act No. 5 of 1983), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following amendments to Telangana Medical Colleges (Admissions into Post Graduate Medical Courses) Rules, 2021, dated : 18.11.2021.

1. In Rule IX under the head 'SELECTION PROCEDURE' after sub- rule (i), the following shall be added:-

No fresh registrations are permitted after the last date of online registration as notified by the University.

All registered and eligible candidates shall exercise web options from the first phase of counseling onwards. If the candidate does not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, he/she shall not be eligible for further phases of counseling.

2. In Rule IX under the head 'SELECTION PROCEDURE' after of sub- rule (XV), the following shall be added :-

The Principals of all Medical colleges shall have in their custody the original certificates of all the admitted candidates and these shall be verified by the inspection teams constituted by the University/State Government after every phase of counseling.

3. In Rule IX under the head 'SELECTION PROCEDURE' after of sub- rule (XVI), the following shall be added :-

Candidates shall be permitted to submit bank guarantee for tuition fee of ensuing academic year within one month after closure of admissions.

4. In Rule IX under the head 'SELECTION PROCEDURE' in place of sub- rule (XVII), the following shall be substituted :-

After second phase of counseling, admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw from the course and admitted candidates are not eligible for upgradation in the subsequent phases of counseling of All India Quota or State Quota of admissions.

5. In Rule IX under the head SELECTION PROCEDURE in place of sub- rule (XVIII), the following shall be substituted :-

The candidates who are admitted into PG courses (Competent Authority Quota, Management Quota, All India Quota) in the second phase of counseling onwards including slided candidates (candidates who have joined in the previous phase of counseling) have to continue in the course without fail to prevent wastage of seats and to prevent seat blocking. Otherwise, all such candidates will be debarred for three years for admission into Postgraduate Medical Degree /Diploma course in the state of Telangana besides payment of Rs.50,00,000-00 (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) to KNRUHS towards forfeiture of bond.

6. In Rule XI under the head ADMISSION RULES in place of sub- rule (II), the following shall be substituted :-

All the candidates joining the Postgraduate degree or diploma course (Competent Authority Quota, Management Quota, All India Quota) should execute a bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- value to ensure undertaking to complete prescribed period of training. In case of the default, such candidate shall pay an amount of Rs.50,00,000-00 (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) to KNR University of Health Sciences.

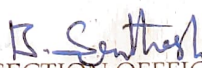
