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ORDER:

Registrar, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal in the letters 5th, 7th, 9th and 10th read above and the Director, Sainik welfare in the letter 8th read above and DME, Hyderabad in the letter 11th read above inter-alia, has proposed certain amendments to the Rules of Admissions into MBBS & BDS Courses as notified in G.O. 2nd read above.

2. The Government, after careful examination of the matter, have decided to amend the Telangana Medical & Dental Colleges Admission (Admissions into MBBS & BDS Courses) Rules, 2017 issued in G.O. 2nd read above and in supersession of G.O 1st and G.O. 6th read above .

3. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the Telangana Gazette Dated: 04.07.2023.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (Act No. 5 of 1983), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following amendments to Telangana Medical & Dental Colleges Admission (Admission into MBBS & BDS Courses) Rules, 2017 issued vide G.O.Ms.No.114 HM&FW (C1) Department dated.05.07.2017.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules,

- (1) In Rule (3),
 - (a) for clause (a), under the head 'Eligibility Criteria for Admission', the following shall be substituted, namely, -

(P.T.O)

“a) Nationality and Domicile: The candidates should be Indian Nationals (or) Person of Indian Origin (PIO) Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) card holder (PIO/OCI status issued before 04.03.2021) and should satisfy Local, Non-Local status requirement as laid down in the Telangana Education Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order 1974 as amended in G.O. (P) No. 646 Education (W) Department, dated: 10.07.1979.”

(b) in sub Rule (IV), for existing clauses (c) (d) (e) (f) and (g), the following shall be substituted, namely,-

“(c) CAP (Children of ex-servicemen and service personnel): 1%

Note: The above reservation is applicable only to the children of Ex Servicemen and Serving Personnel of the three wings of the Armed Forces viz., Army, Navy and Air Force who are **domiciled** in Telangana based on the permanent address / home town declared by them while joining the service and as recorded in their service register”

(d) PMC (Police Martyrs children): 0.25%

The priorities for selection in respect of categories c & d mentioned above shall be as per directions issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time.

Note: The candidates claiming reservations benefits under above mentioned c,d categories shall produce original documents in support of their claim and the verification of above certificates shall be completed and priority list to be submitted to the University by the following authorities,-

*CAP - The Director, Sainik Welfare Department, Telangana

*PMC - The Director General of Police, Telangana.

The decision of above authorities is final with regard to finalization of priority.

*The priorities for selection will be notified by the respective Director/ Government from time to time which will be implemented for selection and for admission.

The Director, Sainik Welfare Department, Telangana and the Director General of Police, Telangana are authorized to depute the officers to the respective verification center in the State without fail on receipt of requisition from the Registrar, KNRUHS, Warangal. The verification officers deputed shall attend duties continuously at the verification centre as per schedule, without fail. The verification officers shall submit final merit/priority list in time-bound manner to meet the schedule of selection to the Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences, Warangal without fail. The decision of the verification officers with regard to finalization of priority / merit list is final in all respects. KNR University will fill- up the seats as per the merit list / priority list prepared and submitted by the respective departments. TA, DA and honorarium will be paid by the University.

(e) Reservations for Anglo Indians:

One (1) BDS seat in Government Dental College, Hyderabad, which is a state wide institution shall be reserved for Anglo Indian candidate from un-reserved seats. The candidates shall produce certificate in support of his / her claim in the prescribed proforma issued by Mandal Revenue Officer subject to scrutiny and conformation by the Secretary, Department of Minority Welfare, Government of Telangana.

(f) Reservation for children of employees of Singareni Collieries in Ramagundam government medical college:

Out of 150 MBBS seats of Ramagundam Government Medical College, 5% of the 127 seats under state quota (after deducting 23 seats of All India Quota) rounded up to Seven (7) seats shall be reserved for children of employees of Singareni Collieries. SC, ST,BC category reservations shall be applicable and allotment will be based on NEET

Merit in respective categories. The candidate shall produce a certificate in support of his/her claim from the Managing Director, Singareni Collieries to avail of this reservation”.

- (c) in Sub- rule (V), for clause (e), the following shall be substituted, namely,-

- (2) In Rule 4, after clause(iii), and the paragraph thereunder, the following clause shall be inserted namely,-

“(iii) (a) Grace marks for NCC cadets:

NCC cadets (who have obtained NCC certificates prior to qualifying exam i.e. intermediate or its equivalent) who have qualified NEET UG and who have applied for admission, shall be provided with grace marks to be added to NEET score as follows:

Category	% of Grace Marks
i. Participation in Republic Day Camp (RDC)	: 7%
ii. Participation in Thal Sainik Camp (TSC)/ Vayu Sainik Camp (VSC) /Nau Sainik Camp (NSC)	: 5%
iii. NCC 'B' Certificate	: 3%

The Director NCC, Telangana State shall depute officers to the verification centre as per the requisition from Registrar, KNRUHS, Warangal. The verification officers shall submit candidate wise verified certificates list to Registrar, KNRUHS. The decision of verification officers is final with respect to verification of above certificates. KNRUHS will prepare merit list after addition of grace marks as per the verified data submitted by the Directorate of NCC.

- (3) In Rule 7, for clause (iv), the following shall be substituted namely,-

(iv) SANCTION OF LEAVE BEYOND (3) MONTHS AND TERMINATION OF STUDENTSHIP:

- Every candidate after his admission shall attend classes on all working days (Theory, Practicals, Clinicals). If a student absents continuously for a period of (91) days or more and seeks permission to attend the course before 2 years after discontinuation, the candidate's application in the prescribed proforma shall be forwarded to the Registrar with the recommendations of the Principal with requisite fees. If the Vice Chancellor is satisfied with the reasons for absence, the candidate may be granted leave of absence and be permitted for Re-admission attaching such conditions as deemed necessary. Candidates who are absent for a continuous period of more than 2 years shall be deemed to have forfeited the admission into the course and the studentship shall stand cancelled without any further notice.
- If the break of study (91 days or more) is in more than one spell, the candidate's application in the prescribed proforma shall be forwarded to government for appropriate decision in the matter with the specific recommendations of the Executive Council of the university.
- Candidates, who are absent for cumulative period of more than (2) years, shall be deemed to have forfeited the admission into the course and the studentship stands cancelled without any further notice.

- d. The candidate has to pass the final examination for award of Degree for the course within double the duration of study period for the course or within the maximum period permitted by the National Medical Commission from time to time.
- e. On Re-admission the study period for the course shall be extended equivalent to the period of absence and the candidate shall be eligible to appear for final examination after completion of the extended study period for the course”.
