PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO NPM COURSE - 2026-27

REGULATIONS:

1. The following are the regulations for admission of students into Nurse Practitioner in Midwifery course in Colleges affiliated to KNR University of Health Sciences for the academic session 2026-27.

2. Number of Seats:

The number of seats available for admission into Nurse Practitioner in Midwifery Course for the academic year 2026-27 shall be notified before counselling on KNRUHS website.

3 . ELIGIBILITY:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA:

(as per G.O. Ms. No. 150 HM&FW(C1) Dept., dated 28-10-2024 for PG Nursing courses)

Nationality & Domicile:

The Candidate for admission into Post Basic Diploma in Midwifery Nursing course should be Indian National, Person of Indian Origin/Overseas Citizen of India card holder and shall be a local candidate:

- (i) The seats earmarked as Convenor (Government) Quota, shall be reserved and filled up by the local candidates from the common merit list of the entrance test.
- (ii) 'Local candidate' means a candidate who has studied in the Educational Institutions in the state of Telangana as for a period of not less than four (4) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.

The Candidates must satisfy the INC notified eligibility criteria as detailed below:

1)	Age	45 years or younger at the time of admission.(As per INC Regulations)

2)	Educational Qualification	The candidate seeking admission to this program should have the following qualifications: a) Be a RN (Registered Nurse) & RM (Registered Midwife) with Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery or B.Sc. (Nursing) qualification. b) Possess a minimum of two-years of recent clinical experience in the maternity care. c) Only In-service candidates are eligible for admission and will be receiving their regular salary. NOTE:- The candidate in order to practice mid-wifery during the period of training has to obtain temporary/transfer registration (RN & RM) in the respective State where the candidate is enrolled in the NPM Program. d) All candidates should be Indian National and should satisfy Local candidate status as per G.O.Ms. No. 150, HM&FW (C1) Department, dated 28.10.2024.
d)	Selection of candidates	Selection of candidates shall be based on entrance test score and Interview score
e)	Physical fitness:-	The candidate shall be medically fit.
4.		<u>Entrance Test Centre:-</u> The Entrance Test shall be conducted on 30-08-2026 at a test center in Hyderabad. The details of the center shall be provided in the Hall-Ticket. <u>Download of Hall Tickets:</u> The eligible candidate shall download the hall ticket through online from 26.08.2026 from the link provided in the website http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in. by entering his/her application number and date of birth in (DD/MM/YYYY) format.

6		<u>Date and Time of Computer based entrance test:</u> 30.08.2026 from 2.30 PM to 4.00 PM Reporting time at the entrance test center – before 1.30 PM

4. RESERVATIONS:

- 4.1.1 15%, 10% and 29% seats are reserved for SC, ST and BC candidates respectively (A-7%, B-10%, C- 1%, D-7% and E-4%) duly following net group reservation.
- 4.1.2 15% seats under Competent Authority Quota shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes. As per G.O. Ms. No. 10, SCD(POA.A2) Dept., Dated: 14.04.2025 and as per Government orders dated. 16.05.2025, out of 15% of seats reserved for SC, 1% of seats shall be reserved for SC Group I, 9% of seats shall be reserved for SC Group II, 5% of seats shall be reserved for SC Group III. The Rationalization of reservations shall be followed as per the said G.O. and Government orders from the AY 2026-27
- 4.1.3 In the event that if any seats reserved for S.T. not being filled up, they will be thrown open to the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and vice-versa.
- 4.1.4 In the event of the candidates from the SC and ST are not being available, these seats shall

be allotted to the candidates under open competition.

- 4.1.5 If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Class of particular group are not available, the leftover seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates of General Pool.

- 4.1.6 From the total seats, 10% of seats are reserved for EWS category candidates.

4.2. CERTIFICATE OF CASTE:

- 4.2.1 Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish a latest caste certificate issued by Competent Authority of Government of Telangana in the prescribed form appended to the application. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form the candidate shall not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 4.2.2 The Social Status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No. 58, Social Welfare (J) Department, dated 12-05-1997.
- 4.2.3 EWS category candidates shall submit the latest EWS certificate issued by Competent Authority for the year 2026-27

4.3 RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES

- 4.3.1 All the seats earmarked for convener quota are reserved for candidates as per G.O. Ms. No. 150 HM&FW (C1) Dept., Dt: 28.10.2024, local candidate is defined as a candidate who has studied in the Educational institutions in the state of Telangana for a period of not less than four (4) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.

4.4 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

- 4.4.1 A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area, if he studied in the Educational Institutions in the state of Telangana for a period of not less than four (4) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.
- 4.5 The applicant who claims to be local candidate shall produce in the form of study certificate/certificates issued by the Head of the Educational Institution / Institutions concerned indicating the details of the year or years in which the candidate has studied in educational institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first

5. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of the course shall be 18 months.

6. APPLICATIONS:

- 6.1 The online application form will be available on the website www.knruhs.telangana.gov.in from **08.08.2026 to 17.08.2026.**

Note: The candidates are advised to take a print out of the prospectus / instructions to fill the application form from the website www.knruhs.telangana.gov.in before proceeding to fill the application form.

- 6.2 The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required-for, through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet café/net center). The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates, Scanned Photo and Signature in the .jpg/.gif format separately (as shown below) (step-1) and ready to enter his/her correct data and upload the photo and signature after the payment of application fee through Online.

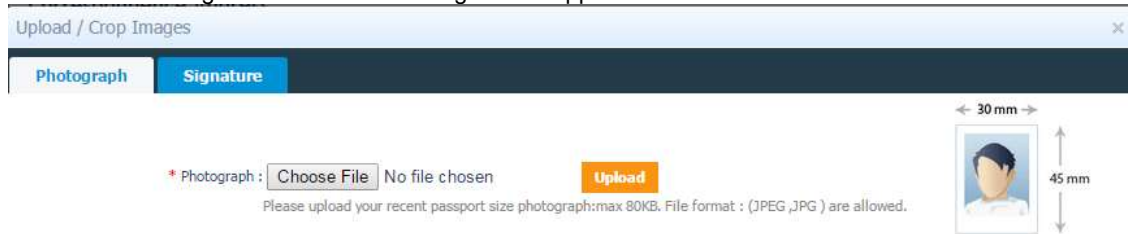

- 6.3 After completing the data entry in all pages of the online application and after submitting the data through online, the candidate should take the print-out of the filled-in online application form. - 6.4 The candidate should paste a recent passport size photograph in the space provided in the print out of online application form. The Photo should be attested by Gazetted Officer/ Principal of the College (identical to the photo that used for scanning)
- 6.5 Registration Fee:**

8. ENTRANCE TEST:

8.1 Computer Based (Online) Entrance Test will be conducted for admission into the NPM Course.

8.2 The Entrance Test will be conducted on **30.08.2026 from 2.30 PM to 4.00 PM at Hyderabad at the center mentioned in the Hall Ticket.**

8.3 Entrance Test shall consist of 100 multiple choice questions. The details of syllabus for Entrance Test are given at Rule No.8.6.

8.4 The duration of Examination is 90 minutes.

8.5 All the questions will be of one best / correct response type having four alternatives.

8.5.1 Each answer with correct response shall be awarded one mark.

8.5.2 There is no negative mark for incorrect response.

8.5.3 Zero mark will be given for the questions not answered.

8.5.4 Choose the most appropriate answer.

8.5.5 All eligible candidates shall appear for Entrance Test. Only the candidates who appear in the Entrance Test are eligible for admission.

8.5.6 The merit list for the candidates shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance Test subject to **Regulation-10**.

8.5.7 Minimum marks required to qualify in the Entrance Test shall be as per **Regulation 3(d)**.

8.5.8 The answer key will be released and objections if any should be sent to the Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences, Telangana Warangal by e-mail knruhswgl15@gmail.com in the prescribed proforma vide annexure-V of the regulations before the date and time specified.

- 8.6.2 Candidate should report at the test venue one hour before the start of the test. No entry will be permitted after 02.00PM. i.e., commencement of Examination process.
- 8.6.3 Candidates taking the Entrance Examination will be subjected to thorough frisking before being allowed into the hall at the stipulated time.

- 8.6.7 Candidates are not allowed to carry any Text materials, Printed or Written, bits of papers, envelope or any other materials except the Hall Ticket and Photo ID inside the Examination Hall.
- 8.6.8 Pens, Pencils, Calculators, Electronic Digital Watches, Cellular phones, Pagers or any other Electronic gadgets are not allowed inside the examination hall.
- 8.6.9 A bell will be rung at the beginning of the Examination and at the closing time.
- 8.6.10 The Candidate must sign in the attendance sheet at the appropriate place and affix the left index finger impression against the appropriate column of the attendance sheet. Photo Copy of Hall Ticket and Photo ID to be handed over to the invigilator. Failure to comply to this requirement will lead to the annulling of his candidature without any prior intimation.

9 UNFAIR MEANS IN THE ENTRANCE TEST:

- 9.1.1. Hall Ticket is not transferable. Hall Ticket should not be tampered.
- 9.1.2. A person should not Impersonate a candidate.
- 9.1.3. Except Hall Ticket & Photo ID, candidate should not possess any Pen, Pencil, Papers, Books or Notes or Written notes or any type of Electronic gadgets like Pagers, Cell Phones, Computers, Calculators, Bluetooth etc., on her/his clothes, body or table or chair, in to the examination Hall / Centre.
- 9.1.4. Candidate should not talk to another candidate or person inside or outside the examination hall without permission of the invigilating staff.
- 9.1.5. Candidate should not show his/her Monitor to another candidate or he/she should not receive, attempt to receive help from any source, including consulting books, notes or papers or any other matter outside the exam hall or has given help or attempted to give help.
- 9.1.6. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before completion of 1½ hour after commencement of the examination.
- 9.1.7. On completion of answering the questions, he/she should seek permission of the invigilator and leave the hall, only after handing over copy of Hall Ticket and Photo ID to the invigilator.

9.2 Violation of any one or all of the above instructions will be considered as malpractice.

- 9.2.1. Any candidate resorting to malpractice in the Entrance Examination will have his/her examination invalidated and will be disqualified from appearing for PG Entrance Examination for the next 3 years.
- 9.2.2. If a person impersonates a candidate, he/she will be disqualified from appearing for any Entrance examination for five years and if he/she is not on university rolls, will not be admitted to any course for five years and the criminal case will be lodged against him/her in the police station, the candidate who is impersonated also will be disqualified for 5 years.
- 9.2.3. Any items such as Calculators, Pagers, Cell Phones, Computers, Bluetooth or any other electronic gadget found with candidate will be seized and will not be returned.

10. BASIS FOR PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST AND SELECTION:

Marks obtained in the Entrance Test and Interview marks shall be considered for selection

10.1 ENTRANCE TEST RESULTS:

The list of provisionally successful candidates along with their marks, categories and ranks shall be notified in KNRUHS website.

11. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:

Candidates in the merit list shall be called for Interview and selections shall be based on marks obtained in the entrance test and Interview

12.1 COUNSELING PROCEDURE:

For Competent Authority Quota:-

- 12.1.1 The University shall constitute a Selection Committee.
- 12.1.2 The venue of selections shall be notified by KALOJI NARAYANA RAO UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, Warangal.
- 12.1.3 All the Qualified candidates at the NPM Entrance Test 2026-27 may attend the counseling
- 12.1.4 The Selection Committee shall provisionally select the candidates as per these regulations from among the candidates who qualified in the Entrance Test/Interview and as per merit list.
- 12.1.5 The candidates shall submit their option to the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will select the candidates as per the Admission Regulations and Government Rules from among the candidates who physically present themselves and submitted their options. The list of provisionally selected candidates will be displayed and the provisional selection intimations will be issued to the selected candidates.
- 12.1.6 The Selection Committee shall have power to review the provisional selection in case of any errors, misrepresentation, fraud or glaring injustice. In all matters relating to selections and admissions the decision of the Selection Committee shall be final and binding on the candidates and selections cannot be questioned after admissions are closed.
- 12.1.7 If a candidate after allotment fails to pay fees or after paying the fees fails to submit the bond, her/his selection stands cancelled automatically.
- 12.1.8 Vacancies will be filled by the Selection Committee on the dates as per schedule.
- 12.1.9 After first selections if any vacancies, will be open to all the candidates with merit order below the merit order of the candidate who vacated the seat for that specialty, in that area and also candidate who were absent in the earlier selection.
- 12.1.10 The provisional selection shall be subject to the condition that the candidates satisfy the Principal about the correctness of certificates given in the application form and also about the eligibility.

13. POWERS OF SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- 13.1 The whole process of admission of candidates into NPM course shall be made under the general supervision and guidance of the Selection Committee, constituted by the University.
- 13.2 The Selection Committee shall select candidates in accordance with the provisions of these regulations. The Committee is empowered to take such steps as it considers necessary for early completion of the selection.

13.3 The Selection Committee shall have power to review its decision and either admit or cancel the admission.

14. VACANCIES:

Vacancies if any caused due to failure to join or cancellation of admission or demise of the candidate etc., before the closure of admissions shall be filled by the Admission Committee in accordance with the regulations.

15. JOINING TIME:

The selected candidates shall join the institution concerned within the specified date along with the original certificates and documents required. No request shall be entertained for extension of time under any circumstances. Failure to join the course in time shall automatically result in cancellation of the seat.

16. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

As notified by the University

17. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:

17.1 The Principal/Dean of the College shall verify the authenticity of the documents. If satisfied shall direct the candidate to pay the fees etc., immediately.

17.2 All original documents and declarations shall be preserved in the safe custody of the Principal of the college in order to facilitate any enquiry in future.

18. FEES:

18.1 **TUITION FEE: As notified by Government.**

- 18.2 All the selected candidates shall pay the following University fee in the form of crossed demand draft drawn on ANY NATIONALISED BANK in favour of Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences payable at Warangal along with the bond. The fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

19. POWERS OF THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION:

- 19.1 Not withstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Head of the Institution may, at any time either suo-moto or on an application made by any person, after due and proper enquiry, if he/she is satisfied that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or enclosed false certificates or fraudulently obtained admission, may, for the reasons to be recorded in writing, by order, cancel her admission, provided that no such admission shall be cancelled without giving a reasonable opportunity for showing cause as to why her/his admission should not be cancelled.
- 19.2 Against any such order of the Head of the Institution an appeal shall be with the Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences, Telangana, Warangal.

20. POWERS OF THE KNR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

The KNR University of Health Sciences may either suo-moto or on application made to them call for to examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof, made by the concerned authority for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness, regularity or propriety of such order in relation thereto as they deem fit, including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made provided that the University may, before cancelling such selection or admission give an opportunity to the authority and to the person effected to show- cause against such cancellation.

21. FINALITY OF SELECTION:

All selections made under these rules shall be subject to any general rules or orders that may be made by the KNR University of Health Sciences/ Government from time to time.

22. DEPUTATION:

Regular in-service candidates of Telangana Medical and Health Services shall be on deputation if the respective Directorates deputed.

23. BOARDING AND LODGING:

- 23.1 All should adhere to the institutional rules and violation of rules will be viewed seriously.
- 23.2 The candidates have to pay the fees towards their food if they reside in the hostel along with other fees as prescribed from time to time.

24. LEAVE:

Each year students will be permitted to avail 30 days leave. No candidate is allowed to go on leave more than 8 days at a stretch. In case the absence of the candidate availing Medical Leave / Maternity Leave / Any other Leave or unauthorized absence is beyond 30 days in a year the study period of the candidate will be extended to the extent of such period. No other leave is permitted.

25. UNIFORM:

All the candidates are expected to wear the Uniform on duty prescribed by the Uniform College

26. COURSE OF STUDY:

The candidates admitted into NPM course shall pursue the study in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the KNR University of Health Sciences, Telangana, Warangal.

27. EXAMINATIONS:

The candidates shall have to appear for such examinations as prescribed by the University from time to time.

ANTI RAGGING ACT

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the state of AP vide Act No.26 of 1997, dt. 21-8-1997. The Anti raging Act is placed on the Website of the University for information.
