**NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB-OPTIONS FOR SECOND PHASE OF
COUNSELLING FOR ADMISSION INTO BDS COURSE UNDER COMPETENT
AUTHORITY QUOTA INTO AFFILIATED GOVERNMENT, PRIVATE DENTAL
COLLEGES AND ARMY COLLEGE OF DENTAL SCIENCES, SECUNDERABAD
FOR THE AY 2026-27**

In continuation to this office notifications dated: 04.08.2026, 24.08.2026, 28.08.2026, 04.09.2026 & 07.09.2026, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences hereby notifies to conduct second phase of web-based counseling under Competent Authority Quota (CQ) for admission into BDS course including PWD, Anglo Indian, PMC, CAP categories for the AY 2026-27 into Government, Private Dental Colleges and Army College of Dental Sciences in the State of Telangana.

Candidates whose certificates were uploaded at the time of online registration and verified by staff of concerned departments and whose names are notified as eligible candidates in the final merit list of UG Admissions on the KNRUHS website on 28.08.2026 and subsequent addendums are eligible to exercise web - options online from computer with internet connection.

All the eligible candidates whose names are displayed in the final merit list including PWD, Anglo Indian, PMC & CAP categories candidates on KNRUHS website can exercise web options for admission into BDS course from **02.00 PM on 16.09.2026 up to 11.00 AM on 18.09.2026** through website <https://tsbdsadm.tsche.in/>

For eligibility criteria and regulations, to refer the notifications dated: 04.08.2026.

- 1. The candidates who were allotted seats in the first phase of counselling and have not reported/discontinued the course at the respective dental college are not eligible for exercising web-options.**
- 2. Candidates who have not exercised web-options in the first phase of counselling are not eligible to exercise web-options.**
- 3. The candidates who were allotted BDS seats in the first phase of counselling, joined the course and continuing the course are eligible to exercise web-options.**

UNIVERSITY FEE:

Allotted candidates have to pay University fee of **Rs. 12,000/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand only)** for BDS course through payment gateway by using online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and download the allotment order.

- In case of payment failure resulting in a subsequent successful payment (double payment), candidates shall submit their representation for refund of the failed/duplicate payment only through e-mail to knruhs.doublepayments@gmail.com. Upon verification, the amount received through the failed/duplicate transaction, if any, shall be refunded to the candidate's bank account by following due procedure only after the closure of admissions.

TUITION FEE:

- Tuition fee is to be paid at Government Dental College & Hospital, Hyderabad as notified in college website.
- Tuition fee is to be paid at respective Private Dental Colleges as per G.O.Ms.No. 98, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 07.08.2026.

NOTE:

- The details of seats available (seat matrix) are placed in the website <http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in>. Candidates can exercise web options for BDS course in all Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS through <https://tsbdsadm.tsche.in/>. Candidates can exercise web-options for any number of colleges the candidate is interested to join as per candidate's eligibility.
- The allotment of seats will be made in accordance with the selection procedure notified in Government orders G.O.Ms.No. 114 HM&FW(C1) Dept. Dated:05-07-2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No. 75, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 04-07-2023, G.O. Ms. No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 19-07-2024, G.O.Ms.No. 10, Scheduled Castes Development (POA.A2) Department, Dated: 14.04.2025, G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble High Court/Supreme court orders and University regulations.
- **Candidates are informed that if they exercise web- options for a seat and allotted BDS seat as per their choice in the web- counselling and if they do not join the course at the allotted college, they will not be eligible for exercising web-options for subsequent rounds of counselling.**

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

1. Eligible NEET UG 2026 qualified candidates as per the final merit list for Competent Authority Quota can exercise web options for BDS course in to the affiliated Dental colleges of KNRUHS as per their interest and priority through <https://tsbdsadm.tsche.in> from computer with internet connection.
2. Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus for the Regulations for admission into BDS course and Government Orders on Rules of Admissions before exercising web-options.

3. **If a candidate is allotted a seat in BDS course as per his/her options and does not join the course, they shall not be permitted to exercise web options in the subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.**
4. Candidates exercising web-options for BDS course are informed that there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options. Candidates can exercise web options for any number of colleges the candidate is interested to join as per candidate's eligibility. **If candidates are not interested to join in any college, they should not exercise web-options for the same.**
5. **Candidates in the final merit list are informed that if they do not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, they are not eligible to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.**
6. Candidates are advised to exercise web options for BDS seats in all colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of available vacant seats shown in seat matrix, as vacancies will arise during counselling process due to sliding of candidates from allotted seats in first phase of counselling to other seats as per their web-options in the second phase of counselling.
7. If a seat is allotted in this phase of counselling as per web-options exercised by the candidates in this phase of counselling, the seat allotted in first phase of counselling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore, candidates are informed to exercise web-options carefully for sliding with awareness of this fact.
8. One time pass word will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of exercising web-options. The pass word consists of SIX letter code with English capital A to Z. (For details read instructions to the candidates before giving options)
9. Candidates are instructed to take a print out of saved options.
10. Candidates will receive SMS message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if allotted. Candidates are also informed to login to check their allotment status on <https://tsbdsadm.tsche.in/> website after each phase of counseling.
11. The selected candidates shall download the allotment order from the website after payment of the University fee by gateway method by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates should check their allotment and report to the Principal of respective Dental College on or before the date specified on the allotment order.
12. Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the respective Dental College before the last date for joining as specified on the allotment order, submit all original certificates, relevant bonds and pay the tuition fee/college fee to complete the process of admission. **If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the**

admission process within specified date for joining, the admission will be cancelled automatically and the candidate's options shall not be considered for subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.

13. If the candidate slides to other college during second phase of counselling into the colleges affiliated to KNRUHS, the candidates have to get relieved from first phase joined college, to collect all original certificates, tuition fee and to report at the Principal of allotted college before last date of joining. Candidates who do not join the course at the allotted course in this phase of counselling are not eligible for further phases of counselling.
14. **Candidates are hereby informed that final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the allotted Dental College and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University regulations.**
15. Original certificates submitted at the time of admissions shall not be returned to the candidate, unless the candidate discontinues the course.
16. **The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.**
