ID UNI0275) with an intake capacity of 75 seats (94 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 36 seats (45 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses namely, (i) Ilmul Advia - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan- 10 seats (12 seats including EWS) (iii) Kuliyat-05 seats(06 seats including EWS) (iv) Moalijat-10 seats(12 seats including EWS) and (v) Tahaffuzi-wa-Samaji Tib -05 seats(07 seats including EWS)for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. -reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Govt. Nizamia Tibbia College, Charminar, Hyderabad, Kotla Alijah, Moghalpura, Hyderabad, Telangana 500002 (Inst. ID UNI0275)** inspection was conducted on **18.06.2026 and 19.06.2026 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with an intake capacity of 75 seats (94 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 36 seats (45 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses namely, (i) Ilmul Advia - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan- 10 seats (12 seats including EWS) (iii) Kuliyat-05 seats(06 seats including EWS) (iv) Moalijat-10 seats(12 seats including EWS) and (v) Tahaffuzi-wa-Samaji Tib -05 seats(07 seats including EWS)seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023", MESAR PG Unani 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report and as per the Visitor Observation certain shortcomings/defects were observed.**
- 3) In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **173th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **21.08.2026**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to the college and accordingly a hearing letter was issued to you vide MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 24.08.2026** to appear on **27.08.2026** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the permission to your college be denied for the academic Year 2026-27.**
- 4) The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter no. 2782/ANTC/2026 dated 25.08.2026** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives **Dr. Shahzadi Sultana, Principal and Ms Aisha, Additional Secretary, H & FW, Telangana** appeared before the hearing committee on **27.08.2026** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. - There is deficiency of total 09 teaching faculties, therefore seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 45% of total intake capacity (i.e. Reduction of 34 seats).
- ii) **In the department of jarahat** - There is no faculty member available in the Department of jarahat (department vacant) therefore as per the point no. 4 of the approved policy a College shall be denied permission for the concerned academic session if any of the teaching departments do not have even a single teaching faculty, during assessment.
- iii) **For PG Courses :-** As per the approved policy, in case, the UG course is denied for a particular academic session, then simultaneously the corresponding PG courses conducted by the college for the same academic session shall also deemed to be denied. Therefore, college is not eligible for issuance of permission in any PG Course.

Accordingly, after applying the punitive policy for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of yearly permission with intake capacity of 75 seats (94 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 36 seats (45 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses namely, (i) Ilmul Advia - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan- 10 seats (12 seats including EWS) (iii) Kulliyat-05 seats(06 seats including EWS) (iv) Moalijat-10 seats(12 seats including EWS) and (v) Tahaffuzi-wa-Samaji Tib -05 seats(07 seats including EWS)for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
