**MBBS/BDS ADMISSIONS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA FOR THE
AY 2026-27**

In continuation to the notice dated 03.09.2026 issued by the Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana, based on the communication received from the Director, Tribal Welfare, Telangana, Hyderabad, regarding the eligibility of candidates under the Scheduled Tribe (ST) category of Telangana State, it is hereby informed that the Director, Tribal Welfare, Telangana, Hyderabad, vide Rc.No.1298/TRI/TSV/2026, dated 22.09.2026, has furnished a further list of 37 candidates who are not eligible to claim the reservation benefits under Scheduled Tribe (ST) category of Telangana State for MBBS/BDS admissions. (Letter Attached).

Accordingly, the below mentioned 37 candidates shall not be considered under the ST category for admission to MBBS/BDS courses under Competent Authority Quota in Telangana State and shall henceforth be treated under the Open Category, subject to their eligibility and merit.

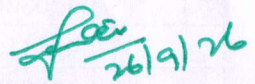

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I invite your attention to the references cited and inform that 13 candidates have migrated from other States viz., Karnataka and Maharashtra. (Civil) No.989 of 1989 the individuals are not entitled to derive benefits from the State of Telangana. Hence they cannot be allotted seats under Scheduled Tribes quota of Telangana State.

The remaining candidates may be allotted seats subject to condition outcome of their social status confirmation by the concerned District Collectors as per the provisions of the Telangana (Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes) Regulation of Issue of Community Certificates Act, 1993 (Act No16 of 1993) and rules thereon.

Ref: Lr.No.8888/MBBS&BDS/KNRUHS/ADMISSIONS/2026-27, dated 03.09.2026, from the Registrar, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana, Warangal.

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I invite your attention to the reference cited and inform that some of the candidates have migrated from Andhra Pradesh to Telangana prior to bifurcation of the state. The list of the candidates is furnished in Annexure-2.

The Hon'ble High Court in cases like *Kukatikonda Jyothirmie vs. State of Telangana (2024)* relied on the *Action Committee* precedent to declare that when a territory is divided due to the reorganization of States, a migrant is entitled to benefits only in their State of Origin, not the state of migration—unless they were an ordinary permanent resident of the Telangana region at the time the original Presidential Orders were enacted.

Essentially, if the roots and family lineage trace back permanently to the AP region, migrating to Hyderabad/Telangana prior to 2014 for employment or education does not transform Telangana into "state of origin" for reservation purposes. The reservation eligibility remains tied to the residual State of Andhra Pradesh.

The Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in its common order dated 10.02.2025 in Writ Petition No.1255, 1359, 2493, 2501, 2506 and 2507 of 2025 held that "23. We propose to deal with each of the conclusions (i) to (ix)...

(x) Insofar as conclusion (x) is concerned, having explained the Judgment in Sudhakar's case which is the Judgment of the Bench of three Judges and the two Constitution Bench Judgments in Marri Chandrashekhar and Action Committee, the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes from any locality which has been divided upon Reorganization of States and such caste or tribe is also recognized as Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe in the newly formed State, such migrant would not be entitled to benefit of reservation in the State of migration but would be entitled only of benefit in the State of origin."

Further, Section 95 of Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 reads that "Equal opportunities for quality higher education to all students" - In order to ensure equal opportunities for quality higher education to all students in the successor States, the existing admission quotas in all government or private, aided or unaided, institutions of higher, technical and medical education in so far as it is provided under article 371D of the Constitution, shall continue as such for a period of ten years during which the existing common admission process shall continue.

The period of ten years is completed as on 01.06.2024 from the date of appointed day of reorganization of the States. Hence, the individuals who migrated to Telangana prior to formation of Telangana State are not eligible to avail the benefit under Art.371D.

**LEGAL STATUS TO CLAIM RESERVATIONS IN TELANGANA WHO
MIGRATED FROM RESIDUAL ANDHRA PRADESH PRIOR TO
FORMATION OF TELANGANA**

The Hon'ble High Court in cases like *Kukatikonda Jyothirmie vs. State of Telangana (2024)*, relied on the *Action Committee* precedent to declare that when a territory is divided due to the reorganization of States, a migrant is entitled to benefits only in their State of Origin, not the state of migration—unless they were an ordinary, permanent resident of the Telangana region at the time the original Presidential Orders were enacted.

Essentially, if the roots and family lineage trace back permanently to the AP region, migrating to Hyderabad/Telangana prior to 2014 for employment or education does not transform Telangana into "state of origin" for reservation purposes. The reservation eligibility remains tied to the residual State of Andhra Pradesh.

The Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in its common order dated 10.02.2025 in Writ Petition No.1255, 1359, 2493, 2501, 2506 and 2507 of 2025 held that "23. We propose to deal with each of the conclusions (i) to (ix)...

(x) Insofar as conclusion (x) is concerned, having explained the Judgment in Sudhakar's case which is the Judgment of the Bench of three Judges and the two Constitution Bench Judgments in Marri Chandrashekhar and Action Committee, the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes from any locality which has been divided upon Reorganization of States and such caste or tribe is also recognized as Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe in the newly formed State, such migrant would not be entitled to benefit of reservation in the State of migration but would be entitled only of benefit in the State of origin."

Further, Section 95 of Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 reads that "Equal opportunities for quality higher education to all students" - In order to ensure equal opportunities for quality higher education to all students in the successor States, the existing admission quotas in all government or private, aided or unaided, institutions of higher, technical and medical education in so far as it is provided under article 371D of the Constitution, shall continue as such for a period of ten years during which the existing common admission process shall continue.

The period of ten years is completed as on 01.06.2024 from the date of appointed day of reorganization of the States. Hence, the individual who migrated to Telangana prior to formation of Telangana State are not eligible to avail the benefit under Art.371D.
